### **Radiologic Sciences Application Information**

To be eligible for consideration for acceptance into the Bachelor of Sciences in Radiologic Sciences Program, an applicant must:

- have met with the Radiologic Sciences advisor **prior** to turning in a BSRS Application
- tour of a designated clinical site **prior** to turning in the BSRS Application (*See BSRS Brochure*)
- provide evidence of satisfactory student status at CSUN (*example, CSUN student ID number*)
- have completed or be in the process of completing **all** required prerequisite courses
- have completed a minimum of 60 units of college coursework (inclusive of prerequisites)
- submit to an BSRS faculty member by the January deadline:
  - ✓ a complete Radiologic Sciences application packet
  - ✓ all transcripts (recent DPR from CSUN)
- interview with the Selection Committee upon approved application
- show evidence of a **minimum** of 40 hours of Volunteering in a Radiology Department shadowing technologists (alternatives in lieu of the volunteer hours) \*\*see pages 2 & 3

**In order for the application to be considered complete, the following must be included:**

- **Official** transcripts from **all** institutions you have attended **except CSUN**. Please include a recent DPR for CSUN transcripts. Please have the official transcripts sent to you then mail in your application have the transcripts enclosed with the application. Make sure you write the appropriate zip code 91330-**8285**
- Do **NOT only** send the transcripts to Admissions and Records. We need our own official copy.

## Fall 2020 Application for 2021 Admission

Once the application is complete and you have met the above criteria, you will be contacted by the Health Sciences department to be scheduled for an interview. Interview dates are scheduled between February – April. Just a reminder, selection will be based on the following: overall GPA, prerequisite GPA, and interview scores.

### Applications **will not** be eligible for processing, if the candidate has:

1. a GPA of less than 2.50 in overall and prerequisite course work
2. a grade of C- or less in any required prerequisite course
3. a grade of C- or less in any Health Sciences Core course

**NOTE:** All prerequisite courses in progress at time of Final Review of application will be computed in the GPA as a "C." Currently the prerequisite courses, or their approved equivalents (*i.e., by articulation agreements with community colleges*), are:

Bio	101,101L (4)	General Biology (with lab)
Bio	211-212L (3)	Human Anatomy (with lab)
Bio	281 (3)	Human Physiology
*Math	106 (5)	Mathematical Foundations for non-Calculus Physics
Chem	100 (3)	Principles of Chemistry
Physics	100A, 100B & 100BL (7)	General Physics
Soc	150 (3)	Introductory Sociology
Psych	150 (3)	Principles of Human Behavior

\*Passing Math 105 or (102+104), is still acceptable.

**After Selection/Acceptance to the program**, the student must have:

- Valid **CPR verification (approved by the American Heart Association)** titled CPR for the Health Care provider or Basic Life Support (BLS) by the start of the BSRS program.
- a physical exam clearance for the safety of patients and students.
- **obtain his/her own background check** and supply his/her personal identification code to the clinical site for review of his/her criminal background check after acceptance to the BSRS program. **This will be discussed at the May Orientation.** This is necessary to ensure that the background check is reviewed by each facility's Human Resources department for acceptance or rejection prior to professional BSRS program placement. Background check information may not be hand carried by the student to these affiliates. The BSRS faculty will not be responsible for obtaining or monitoring the background checks on individuals. Students not successfully cleared for placement at CSUN BSRS affiliate hospitals will not be eligible to complete the degree in Radiologic Sciences.
- **Immunization records** including MMR, Hepatitis B, and varicella
- QuantiFERON or equivalent TB blood test **This will be discussed at the May Orientation.**
- Drug Test (10-panel) **This will be discussed at the May Orientation.**
