



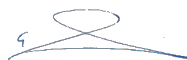

Fractional Amount of Base Salary (\$4,530-\$6,786) Paid in 6 Monthly Installments.

Lecturer A/Rank 2 base salary range is \$4,530 to \$5,405 monthly. For example, teaching 3 units equates to a 0.20 time base (3/15). Calculating the entry level salary of \$4,530 by time base 0.20 for a 3-unit course will be \$906 per month, paid in 6 monthly installments. The total semester salary is \$5,436.

Lecturer B/Rank 3 base salary range is \$5,405 to \$6,786 monthly. For example, teaching 3 units equates to a 0.20 time base (3/15). Calculating the entry level salary of \$5,405, by time base 0.20 for a 3-unit course will be \$1,081 per month paid in 6 monthly installments. The total semester salary is \$6,486.

- Three letters of recommendation
- Additional evidence of teaching training and effectiveness (e.g. student or peer evaluations of teaching) if available
- Transcripts from each university they attended
- A short justification for each class they feel they are qualified to teach. Appropriate justifications include relevant coursework, previous teaching training and experience, and relevant work or volunteer experience.
- Sample Syllabi
- Teaching Philosophy Statement

Note: Incomplete applications will not be considered.

*Current lecturers with a recent personnel file in the department (AY 2022-2023), which includes an updated teaching philosophy statement and current syllabi, must submit a written request specifying which courses they would like to teach along with a short justification for each class they feel they are qualified to teach. 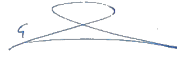
