<b>Title:</b>	<b><u>A.S. President's Day</u></b>
1. WHEREAS:	The Associated Students, Inc. (A.S.) is the official voice of over 40,000 students at California State University Northridge; and
2. WHEREAS:	A.S. is the primary advocate for students at CSUN and provides excellent, meaningful programs and services designed to create and enhance a spirited, learning focused campus environment; and
3. WHEREAS:	Associated Students is a large entity of many departments including but not limited to Sports Clubs, Student Government, Outdoor Adventures, Recycling, Productions, Accounting Services, Ticket Office, Marketing, Information Technology and the Children's Center; and
4. WHEREAS:	The Student Government division of A.S. represents the student body, advocates for its needs and interests among faculty, campus administrators and government officials; and
5. WHEREAS:	To fulfill its mission of providing excellent services and serving the CSUN student population, receiving input and guidance from former student leaders, specifically from our A.S. Presidents and Vice Presidents is extremely valuable to current members of A.S. student government; and
6. WHEREAS:	By acquiring knowledge from A.S. alumni, student leaders can better understand their duties and create strong ties with individuals who have implemented programs and initiatives which have shaped the CSUN campus and paved the way for others to follow; therefore let it be

1. RESOLVED: That the Associated Students, Inc. values the commitment, legacy, and wisdom of its former student leaders who have left lasting contributions to the organization and CSUN community; and
2. RESOLVED: That the Associated Students, Inc. hereby declares that the third Monday of February, President’s Day, shall be annually known as A.S. President’s Day on the CSUN campus; and let it be further
3. RESOLVED: Former Associated Students Presidents and Vice Presidents shall be invited to discuss their student leadership experiences, celebrate past accomplishments, and inspire current leaders in their future A.S. endeavors; and let it be further
4. RESOLVED: A.S. Administration and Student Government Leadership shall be jointly charged with planning and implementing this event as part of A.S. Awareness Month and concerted efforts to outreach to alumni; and let it be further
5. RESOLVED: The day will consist of but not be limited to the following activities:
  - Welcome Reception
  - Senate Meeting (if the meeting is held on President’s Day)
  - Student Leadership Roundtable
  - Tradition of the Rose Ceremony
  - Campus Tour; and
6. RESOLVED: Members of the A.S. Student Government are required to attend this event; and let it be further
7. RESOLVED: A.S. President’s Day will provide the opportunity for former student leaders to maintain a strong sense of Matador spirit and connection to their alma mater; and let it be finally
