Note: All part-time faculty appointments are temporary and do not confer academic rank. Final determination of part-time teaching assignments is contingent upon student enrollment figures and funding. Working in the State of California is a condition of employment.

Expected hiring range is \$1.812 to \$2.162 per weighted teaching unit based on degrees and qualifications. For a typical three-unit lecture/discussion class. this would result in an expected hiring range of \$5,436 to \$6,486. Lab and studio classes usually carry more weighed teaching units and more contact hours.
