MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Completion of at least 75 units toward the B.S. degree.
- 2) Both overall and CSUN GPAs of at least 2.7.
- 3) Student member of ASCM; Contribution to the CSUN ASCM/ASQ as a board member or active student member.
- 4) Agreement to serve on the ASCM-SFV chapter's board for 1 year as a volunteer (at no cost to the student).

CRITERIA FOR AWARD

- 1) Meet all of the "Minimum Requirements"
- 2) Activities furthering knowledge in the SOM and/or GSCM disciplines
 - a. Community service and volunteer work at CSUN, including CSUN ASCM/ASQ
 - b. Work experience in general and in SOM and/or GSCM fields
 - c. Affiliations, Honors, and Awards
