Graduate Assistants provide non-teaching assistance to faculty members and gain practical experience in fields related to their advanced study. Academic Student Employees may not concurrently hold a faculty or staff position. Students with assignments in more than one student classification (i.e., Teaching Associate and Graduate Assistant) are restricted to working a maximum of 20 hours total per week during the Academic Year. The 20 hour per week maximum includes hours worked in all positions. During academic breaks, students may work up to 40 hours per week total.
