On July 13, 2021, Governor Newsom signed budget Trailer Bill AB 130. One key provision of this law is a new coursework option for prospective educators to demonstrate basic skills proficiency. This new provision allows the Commission and its approved educator preparation programs to verify that a candidate has demonstrated basic skills proficiency by accepting qualifying college level coursework from a regionally accredited institution of higher education as long as the following conditions are met:

- For **reading** proficiency: a course in critical thinking, literature, philosophy, reading, rhetoric, or textual analysis.
- For **writing** proficiency: a course in composition, English, rhetoric, written communication, or writing.
- Course must be non-remedial and degree applicable and be at least 3 semester units.
- Course must have been taken for credit or passed with a grade of B- or better.
