On July 13, 2021, Governor Newsom signed budget Trailer Bill AB 130. One key provision of this law is a new coursework option for prospective educators to demonstrate basic skills proficiency. This new provision allows the Commission and its approved educator preparation programs to verify that a candidate has demonstrated basic skills proficiency by accepting qualifying college level coursework from a regionally accredited institution of higher education as long as the following conditions are met;

- For mathematics, applicable coursework must be in the subject of algebra, geometry, mathematics, quantitative reasoning, or statistics.
- Course must be non-remedial and degree applicable and must be 3 semester units (or equivalent quarter units).
- Course must have been taken for credit or passed with a grad of B- or better
