Two paid postdoctoral fellows available to work with BUILD PODER faculty mentors' research labs full-time. The purpose of the postdoctoral fellow program is to support developing BUILD PODER mentors who have a specific plan to either apply for a first NIH grant or to apply for an advanced NIH mechanism. If a pair of PIs are working collaboratively on proposals, they can apply together for this initiative. This initiative is intended to encourage interdisciplinary collaborations. Should the competition be larger than capacity, the PD (Saetermoe) and future co-PDs will consult with outside experts suggested by researchers who will co-rate proposals based on NIH-based criteria.
