## Introducing the CSUN CAPS Program!

In an effort to support the campus Climate Action Plan, Sec3.5 Strategy 16 and Sustainability Plan TR 2.5 for sustainability and clean air, members of the CSUN campus community who drive an “approved” clean air vehicle to CSUN now have specially designated CAPS parking spaces to use!

The Clean Air Parking Spaces (CAPS) are located in several parking lots and can be used to accommodate the parking needs of the following types of vehicles:

1. Plug-in Electric Vehicles
2. Hydrogen Vehicles
3. Compressed Natural Gas Vehicles

## Where can I find out if my vehicle qualifies for the CAPS Program?

Only the vehicles specifically listed by fuel type on the [California Air Resources Board website](#) are eligible. In addition, there may be an added benefit by considering a vehicle on this list as your next vehicle purchase. Any vehicle make/model that also meets the **fuel type criteria** listed with the California Air Resources Board as a “Clean Air Vehicle” qualifies for the CAPS program.

## Do I need a special sticker on my vehicle to use a CAPS space?

No. The only requirement for qualified vehicles to use the CAPS space is to display a valid CSUN parking permit. (Note: Some spaces are located in employee lots, and require the display of a valid employee permit)

## Where are the CAPS spaces?

CAPS spaces are located in campus parking lots adjacent to the EV Charging Stations. An added feature for EV users is the increased chance of finding an available parking space once the maximum time limit for charging at a station has been reached.

In an attempt to accommodate the Electric Vehicle charging time-limit, these spaces are located adjacent to (or near) CSUN EV Charging Stations.
