

**ANNUAL REPORT OF SEXUAL MISCONDUCT**

Reporting Period July 1, 2014 – June 30, 2015

Total reports of sexual misconduct for reporting period: 88

Total after eliminating reports in which the Respondent's identity was unknown or unidentified: 59

Total after eliminating reports in which the Respondent is a Third Party unaffiliated with the university: 33

Regardless of whether investigations were initiated, partially conducted, or completed, all alleged victims/potential complainants were provided with their written rights and options and resources.

- 4) The number of Sexual Misconduct, Dating and Domestic Violence, and Stalking reports resolved without investigation, including a description of the resolution and/or reason for no investigation:

    - i. the alleged victim did not provide sufficient information to warrant further investigation;
    - ii. resolution achieved in accordance with the alleged victim's wishes such as no-contact orders and "cease and desist" conversations with the respondent;
    - iii. alleged victim did not want to pursue and university determined that risk posed to victim and campus did not outweigh victim's wishes;
    - iv. respondent was on interim suspension pending criminal prosecution and withdrew from the university.

    - i. Employee termination from the university (sexual battery)
    - ii. One year suspension from the university to finish degree remotely; cannot re-enroll at University in the future; cannot be present on campus for any reason without prior written approval from Office of VP of Student Affairs; cannot be present at off-campus university events without prior written approval from Office of VP of Student Affairs; no contact with alleged victim (sexual assault)

- iii. One semester suspension; no contact with alleged victim (stalking)
  - iv. One year suspension and educational sanctions (dating violence)
  - v. One year suspension (stalking)
  - vi. Expulsion from CSU
  - vii. One year probation and no contact with alleged victim (stalking)
  - viii. One semester probation and no contact with alleged victim (stalking)
  - ix. 4-year suspension (sexual battery)
  - x. 4-year suspension (sexual battery)
