- Students selected for this path must meet the Masters degree and DI requirements in order to receive a DI verification statement.
- The program has been designed to have the interns complete the MS DI Combined program in 24 months.


1216 Total hours of supervised practice & alternative hours

Completion of Dietetic Internship

- 1216 hours of supervised practice & alternate hours: 10-12 months DI Certificate & 24 months Masters in Human Nutrition DI Combined Program
- Completion of all required graduate courses
- Spanish, cultural sensitivity, MI and BF training
- Meeting all program competencies and student learning outcomes
- Remain in good standing with the University and comply with all rules and regulations as written in the University Catalog and DI Handbook.

Application Requirements

- ✓ Completed DICAS application,
- ✓ Registered D&D Digital Computer matching,
- ✓ A Bachelor's Degree,
- ✓ Current Verification Statement from an approved Didactic Program in Dietetics (DPD) of the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics (A.N.D.) OR Declaration of Intent from the DPD Director,
- ✓ 3 Letters of Recommendation 2 from faculty and one from a supervisor. At least one needs to be a full time nutrition faculty,
- ✓ Official Transcripts
- ✓ Need to submit Supplemental materials in addition to applying through DICAS. (See next Slide)

*GRE is not required for Spring 2024 applications

In addition to applying through DICAS, please use the checklist below and submit supplemental materials by **February 15**th.

- ✓ Personal Statement
- ✓ Authorization for packet review
- ✓ DI Professional Program Contract
- ✓ Proof of Letter of Acceptance to CSUN Graduate program (or a letter indicating that you have applied to the CSUN graduate program.) Please apply now for Fall 2024 and include letter of application in packet. (make sure to apply to the university and the department)
- ✓ Recency of Education Form (if applicable)

Important: Makes sure to check the CSUN DI website for updates.



Selection Criteria

- ➤ Grade Point Average: overall in science and dietetic courses
- Volunteer/ Paid Work Experience in dietetics/foodservice/food science fields. (COM concentration WIC employment)
- Involvement in organizations, scholarships, leadership, honors
- Other languages and cultural experiences are a plus
- ➤ An interview is required for all finalists a 20-30 min interview with a 2-4 person committee.
