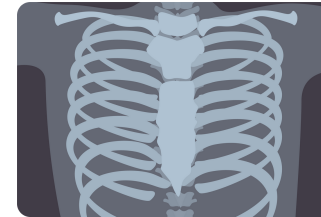

B.S. Radiologic Sciences

About the Program:

Radiologic technologists use high-tech machinery to take images of the inside of the body – images that can then be used by other health care professionals to diagnose and/or treat a patient.



Radiology is focused on creating images of the body's internal structure, organs and tissues. Using X-rays, ultrasound, a CT scan or an MRI.
