A FREE RESOURCE FOR SURVIVORS ON CAMPUS

The **Campus Care Advocates** are certified sexual assault counselors who are available to provide support services to students, faculty, and staff who are survivors of sexual assault, domestic/dating violence, stalking, and harassment. Survivors are eligible to receive support services no matter how long ago the abuse/assault occurred. The care advocates are a confidential resource and not required to report to Title IX.

SERVICES WE PROVIDE:

- **Crisis Intervention and Counseling:** individual and group trauma informed therapy for survivors on a short-term basis.
- **Victim Advocacy:** Intervention with other individuals, departments, and agencies on behalf of victims/survivors. Providing survivors with information on their rights and options as well as linking them to resources on and off campus as needed.
- **Accompaniment:** Support during medical exams for evidence collections, and throughout all stages of university investigation and/or law enforcement or court proceedings.
- **Prevention Outreach:** Provide community education and campus outreach
