## Abstract:

Recent winter storms across California have yet again placed water management issues at the forefront of public consciousness. On the heels of years of historic drought, the state has had to quickly pivot from not having enough water to now having too much. As a warming climate produces both longer & more intense drought, as well as more severe storms, water managers in the West are tasked with dealing with those effects on water supply availability.
