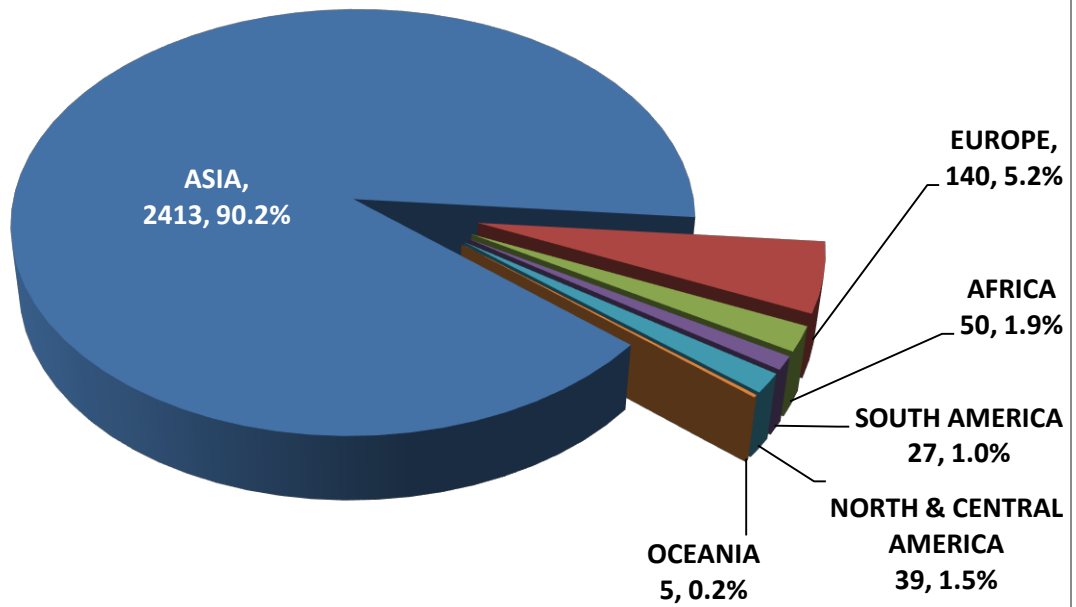

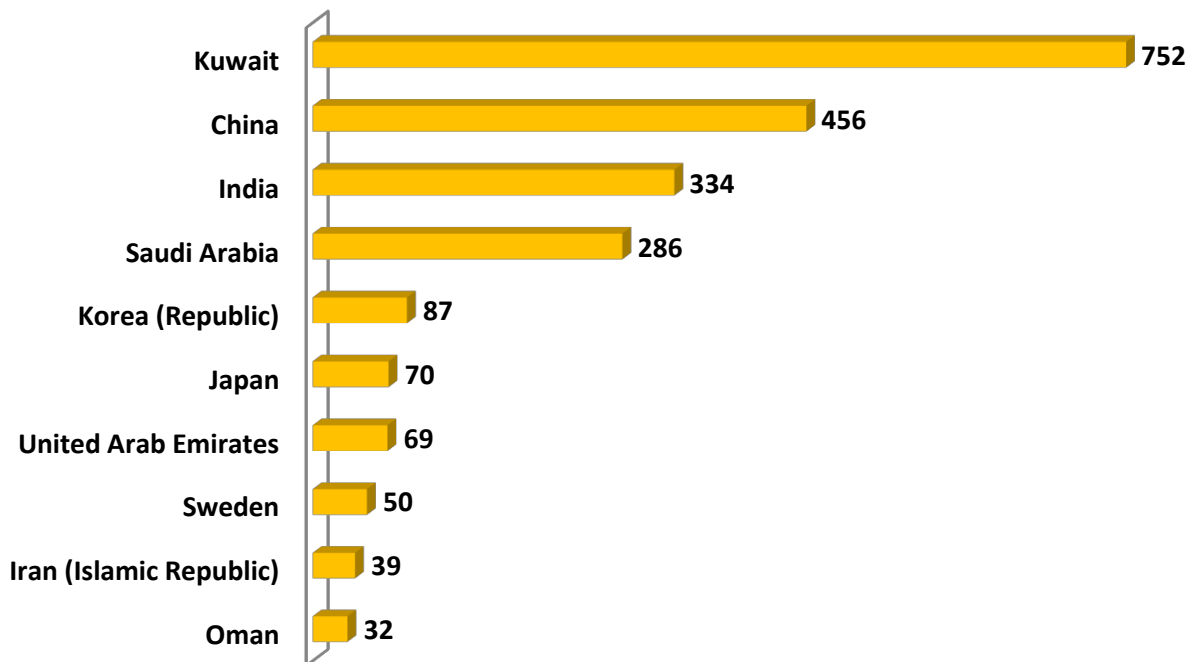

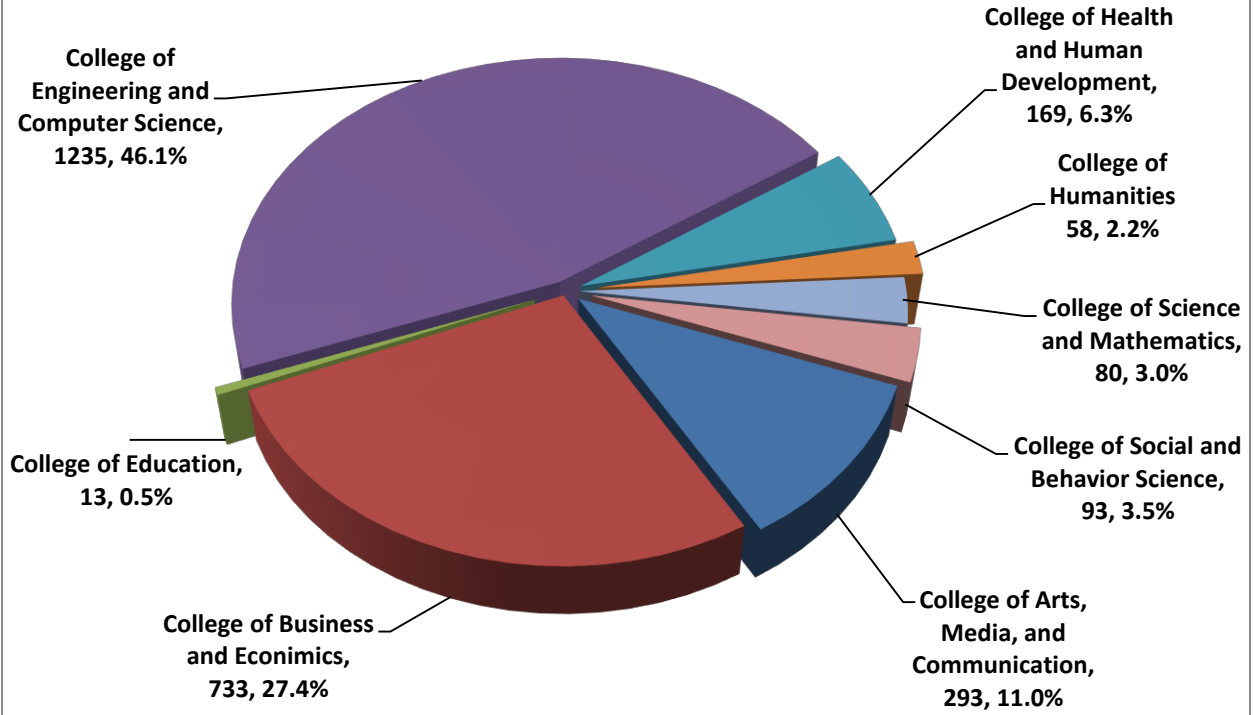
BREAKDOWN BY REGION - FALL 2015



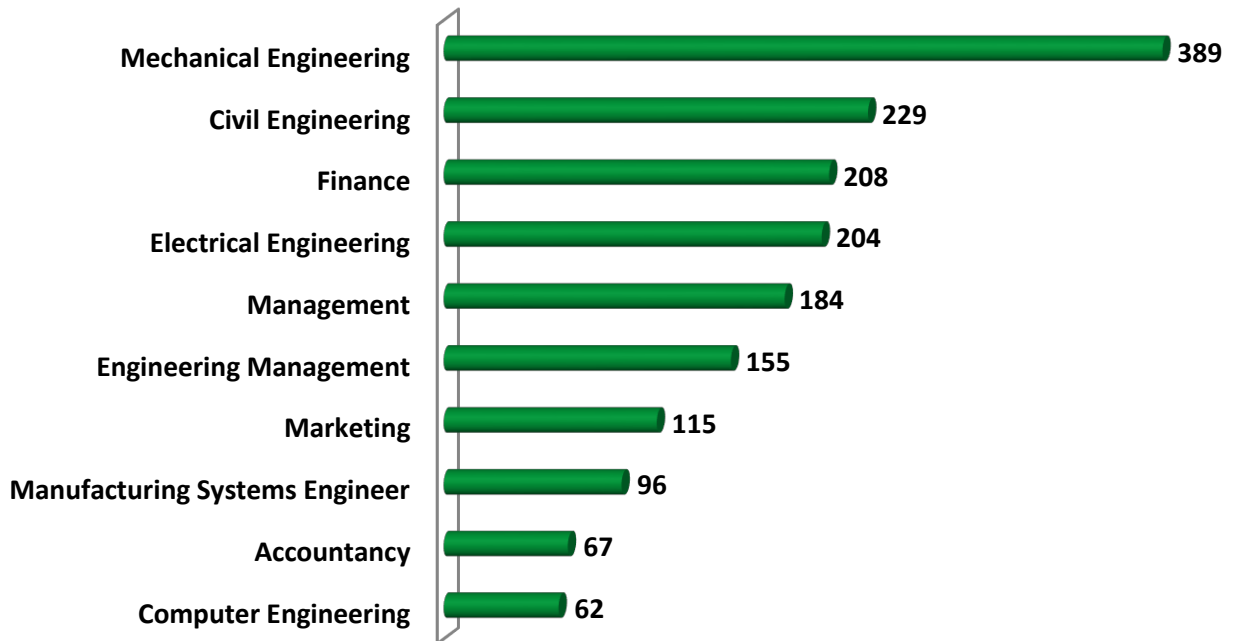
TOP 10 COUNTRIES - FALL 2015
