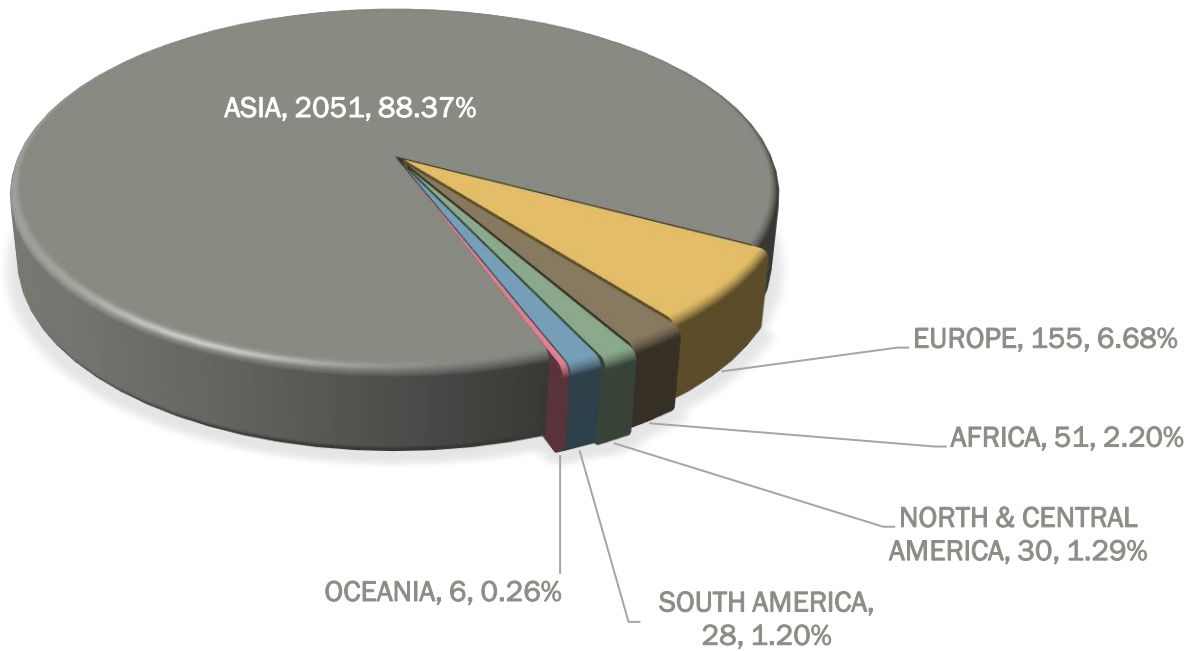

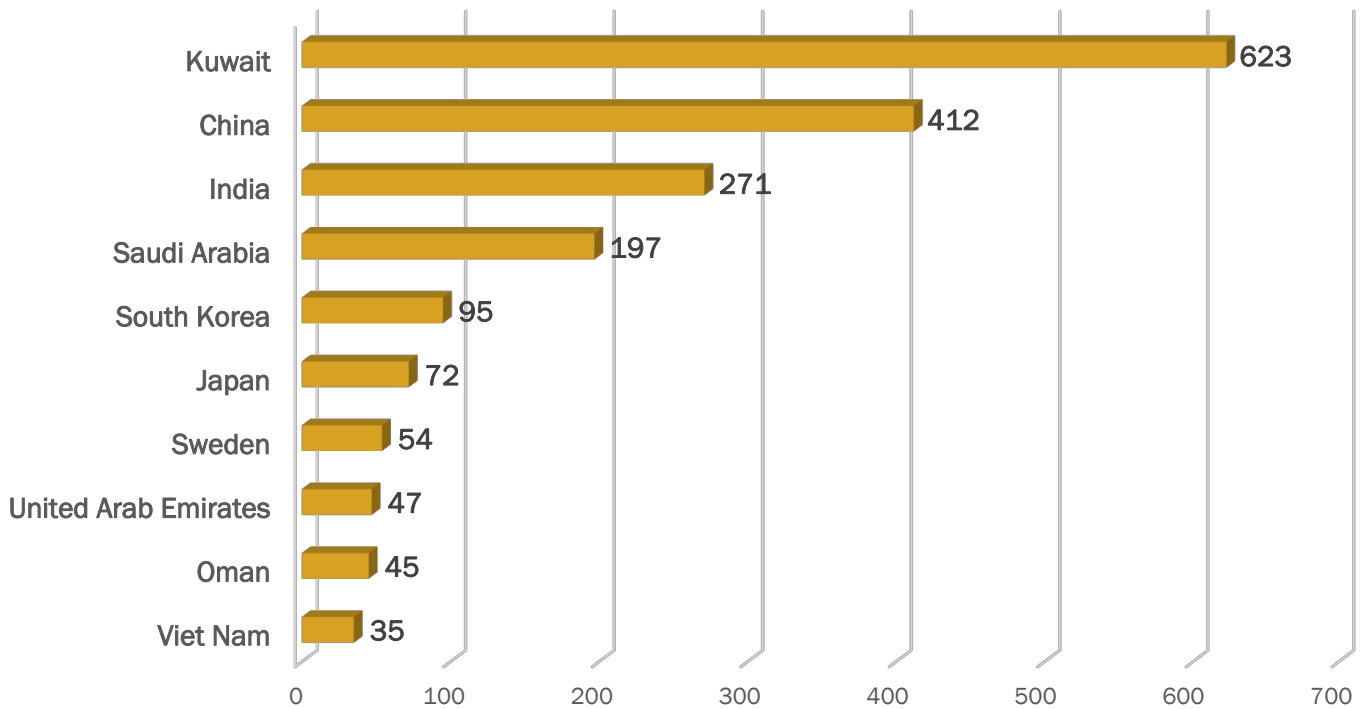

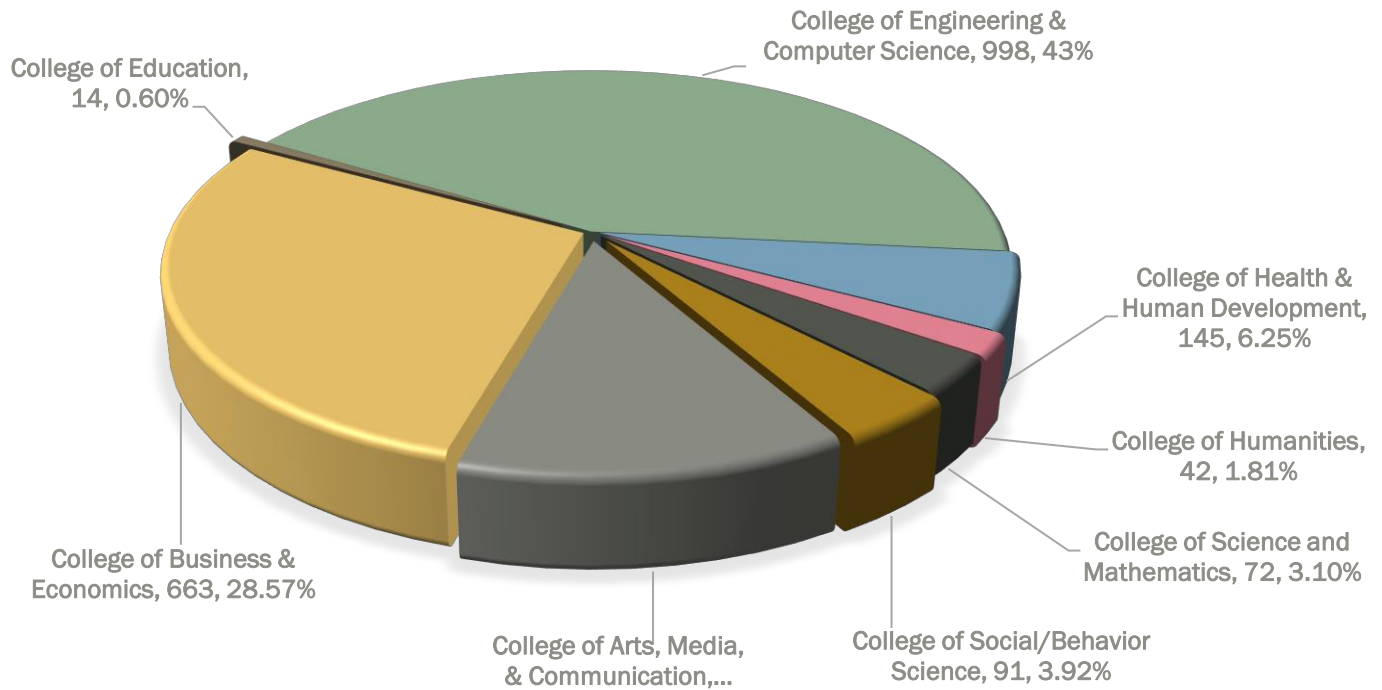
BREAKDOWN BY REGION - FALL 2016



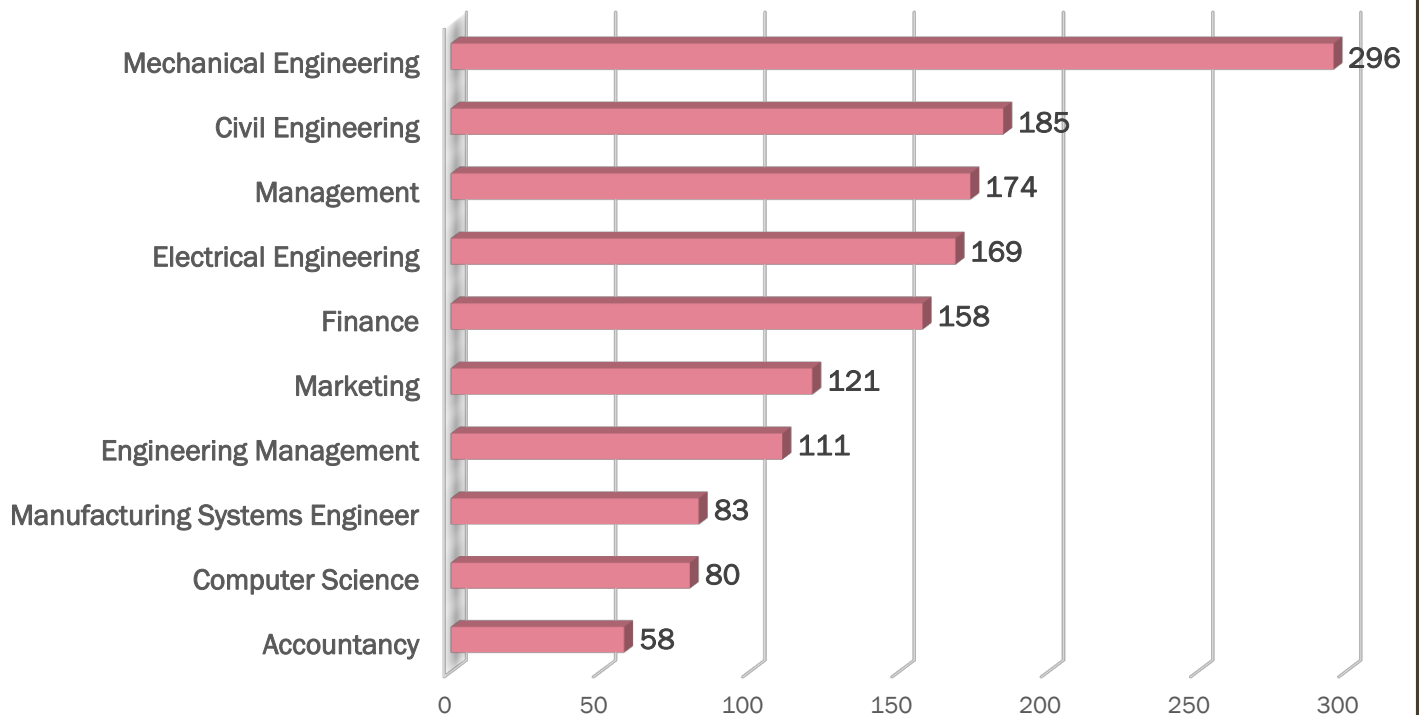
TOP 10 COUNTRIES - FALL 2016
