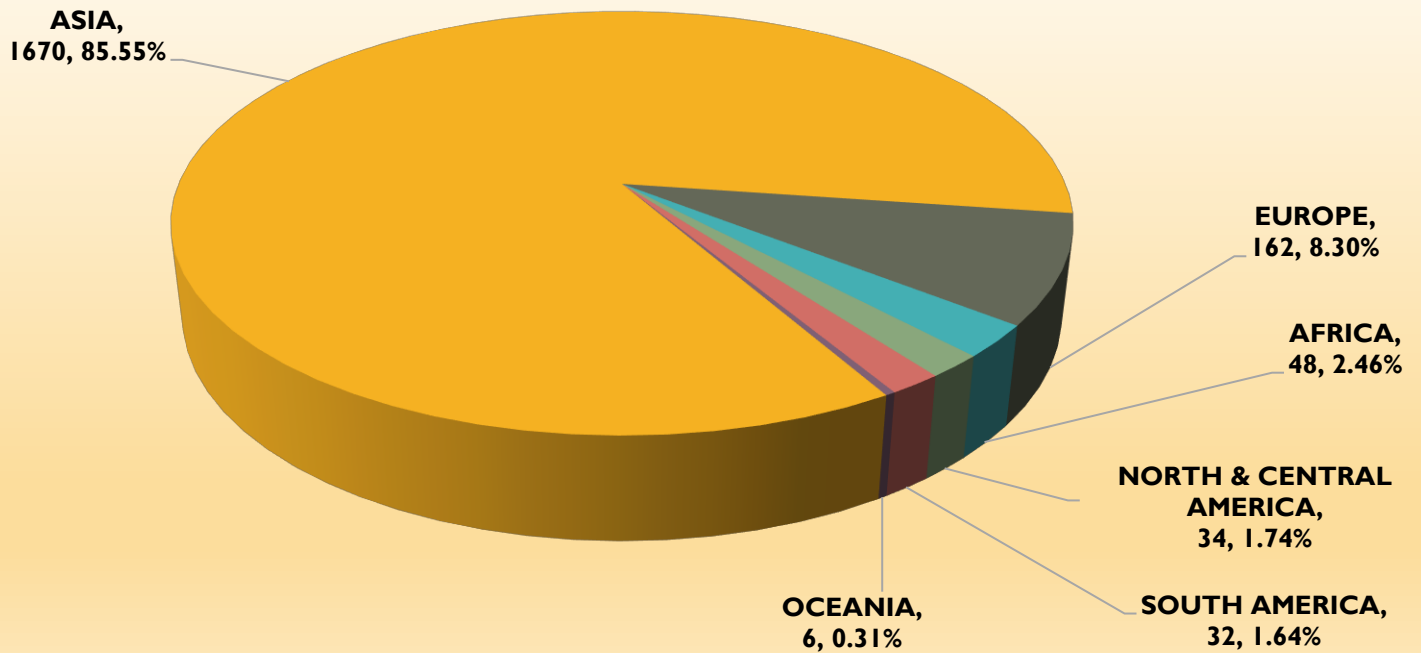

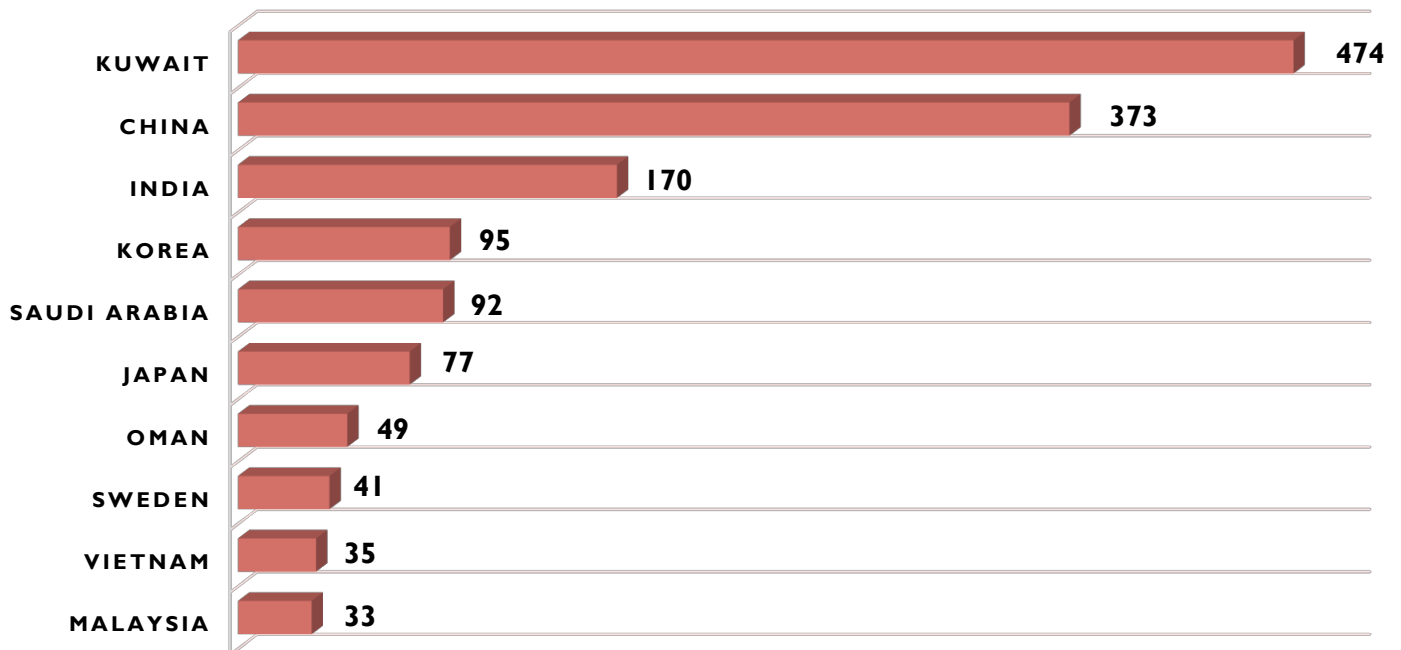

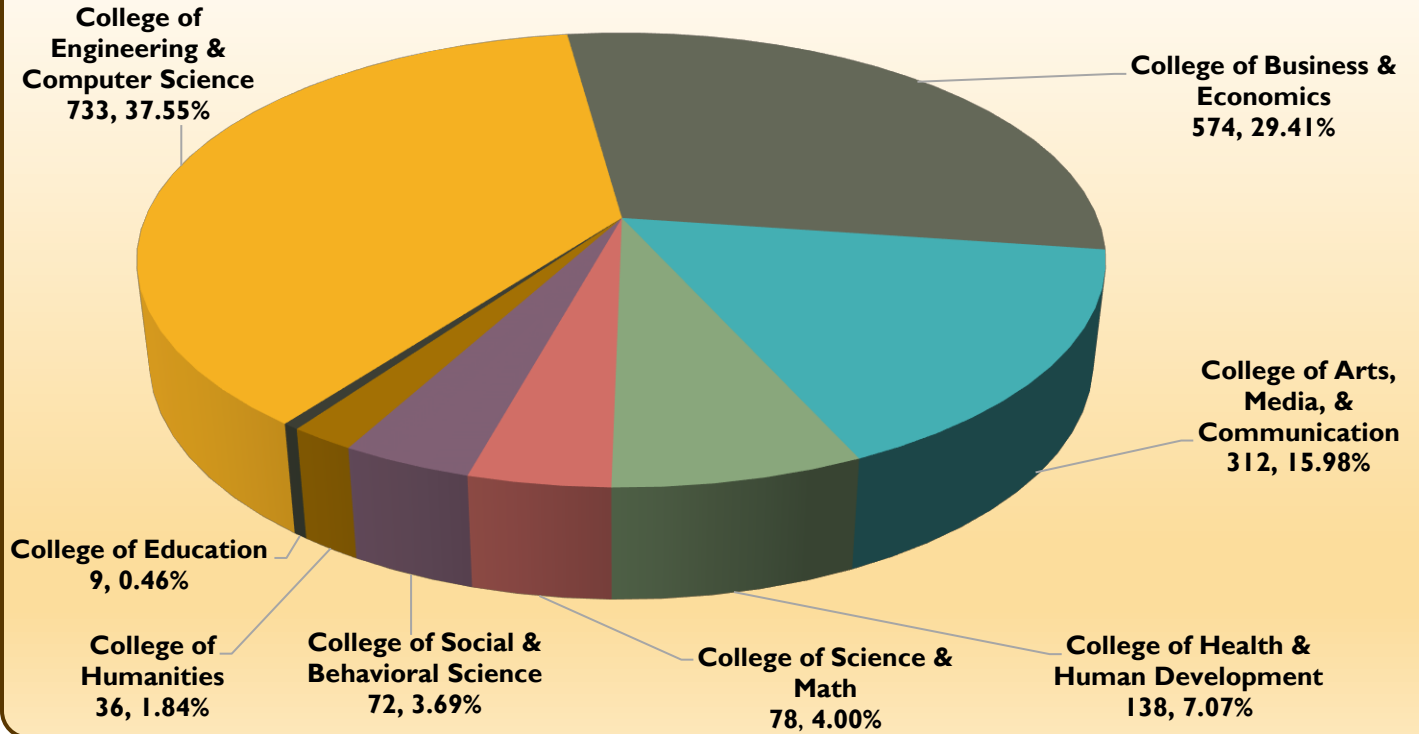
BREAKDOWN BY REGION - FALL 2017



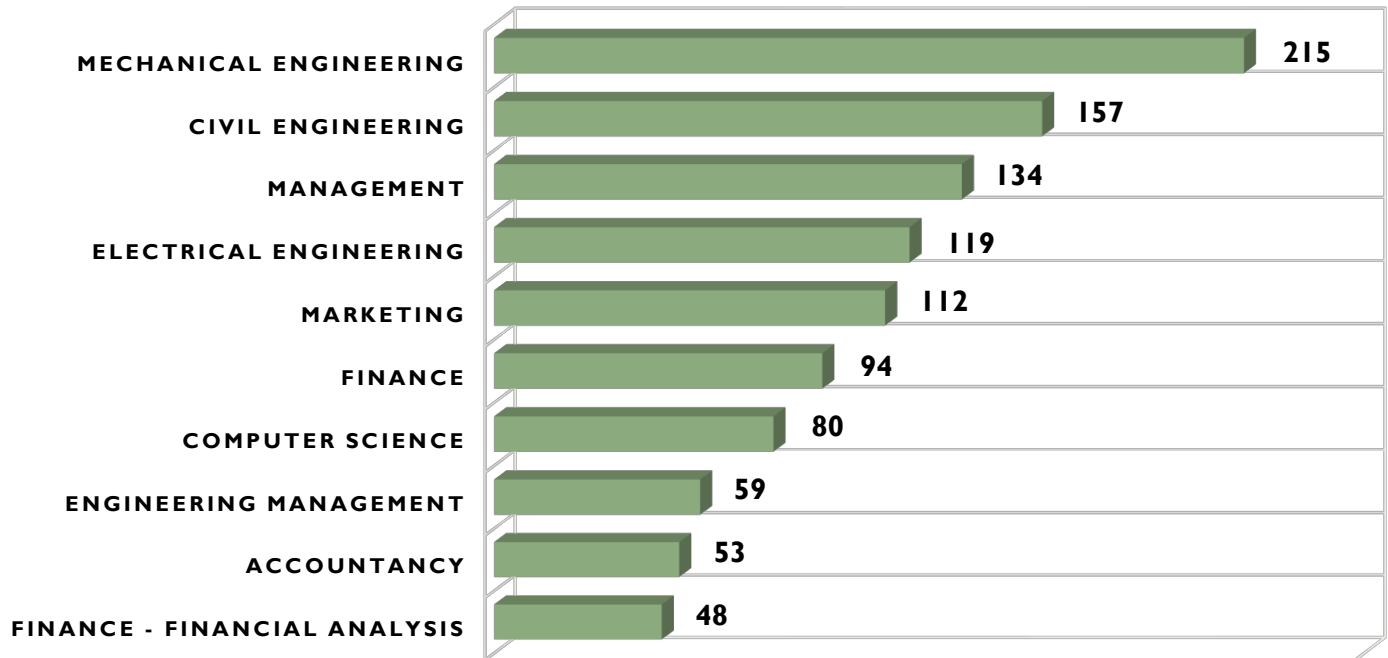
TOP 10 COUNTRIES - FALL 2017
