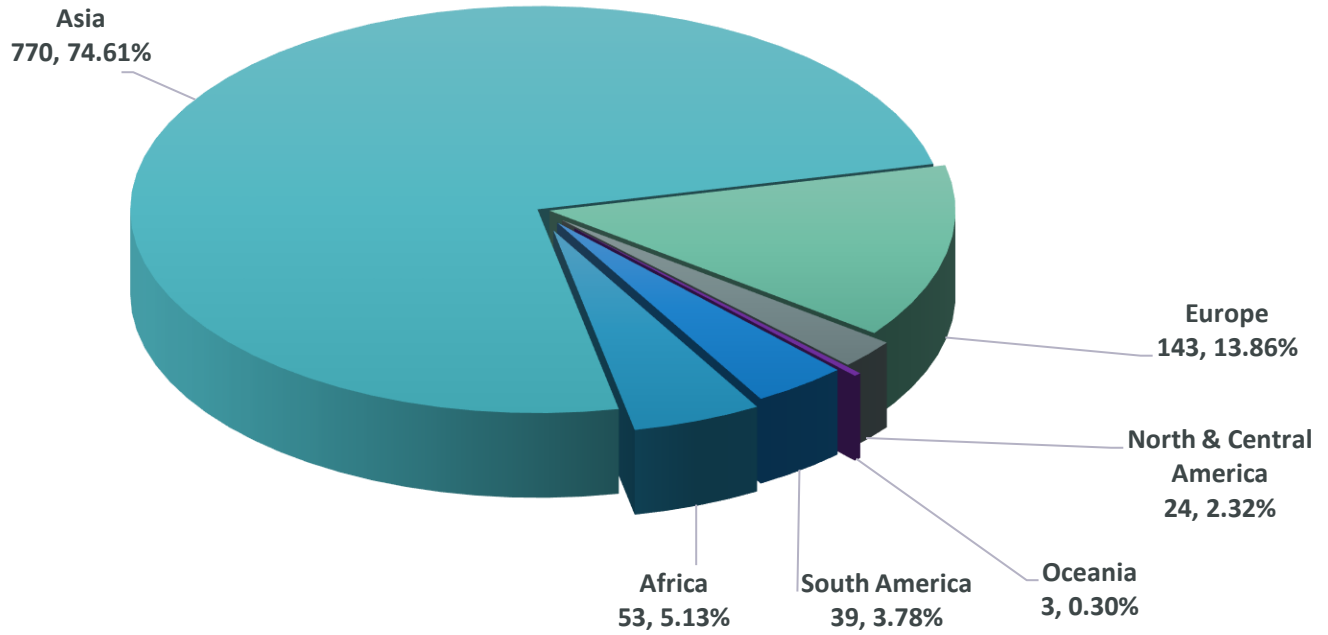

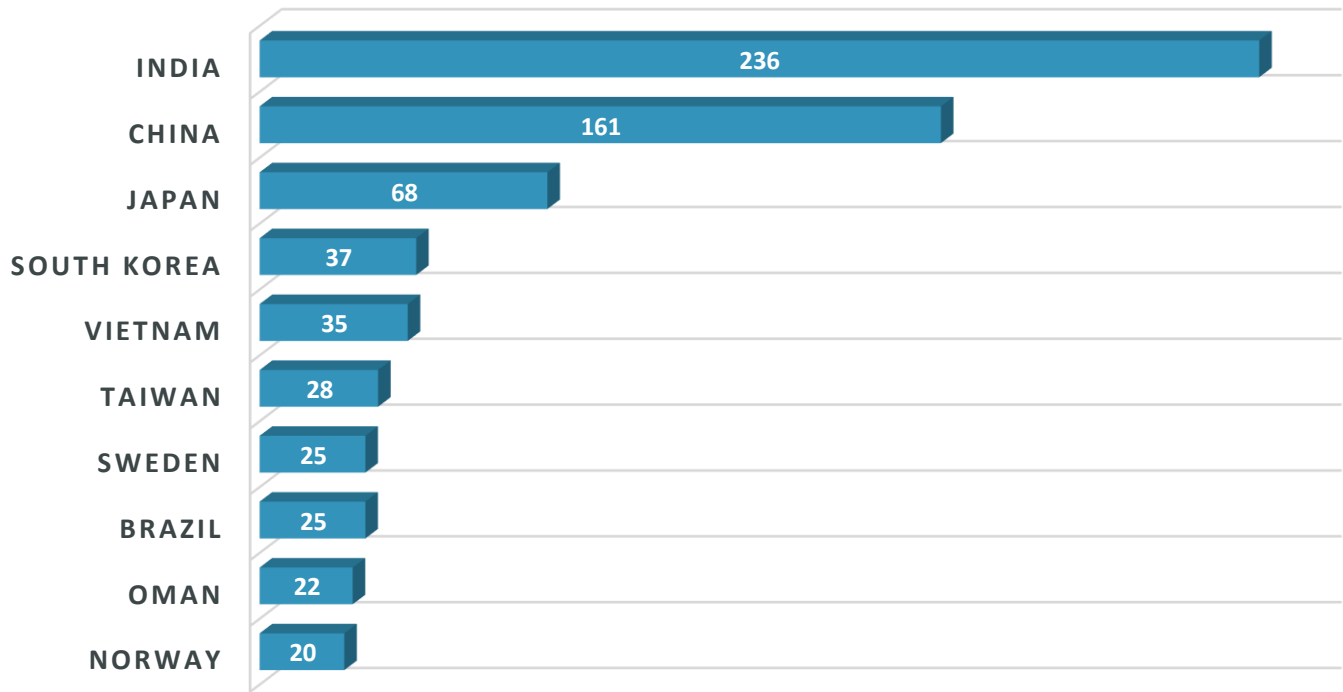

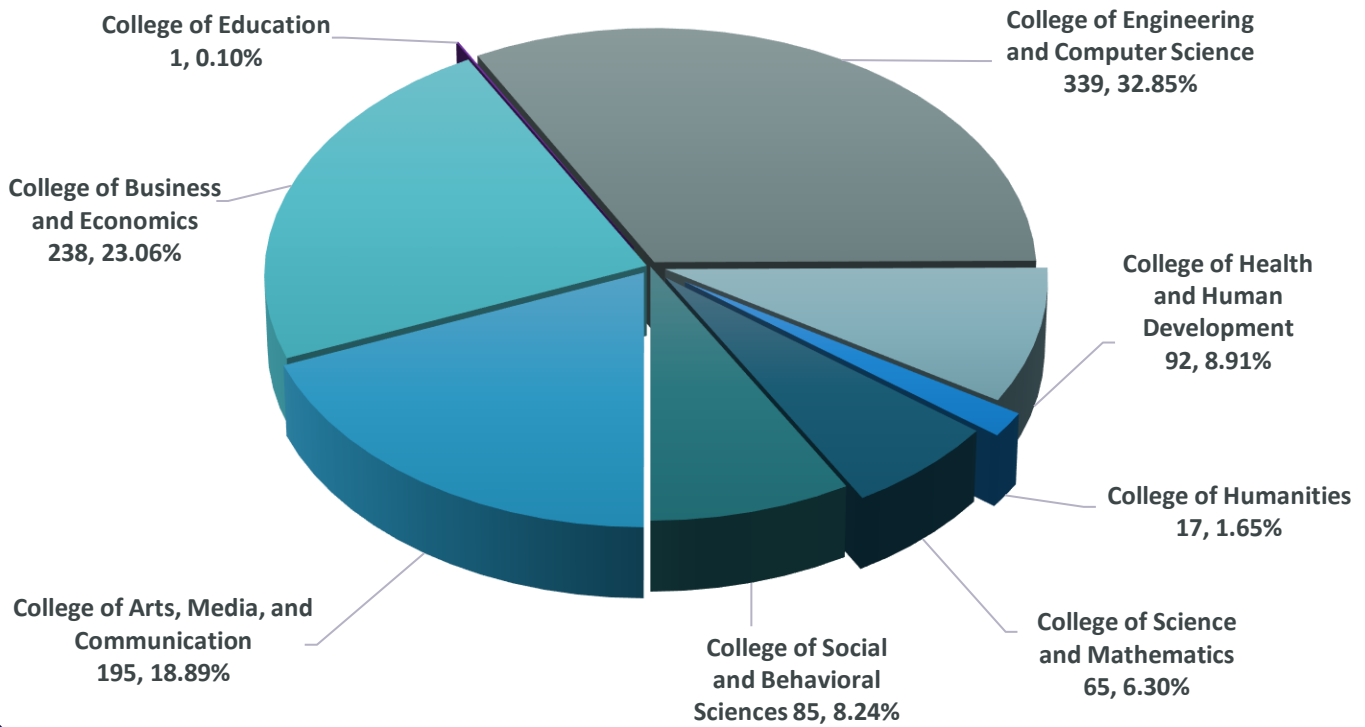
BREAKDOWN BY REGION- FALL 2021



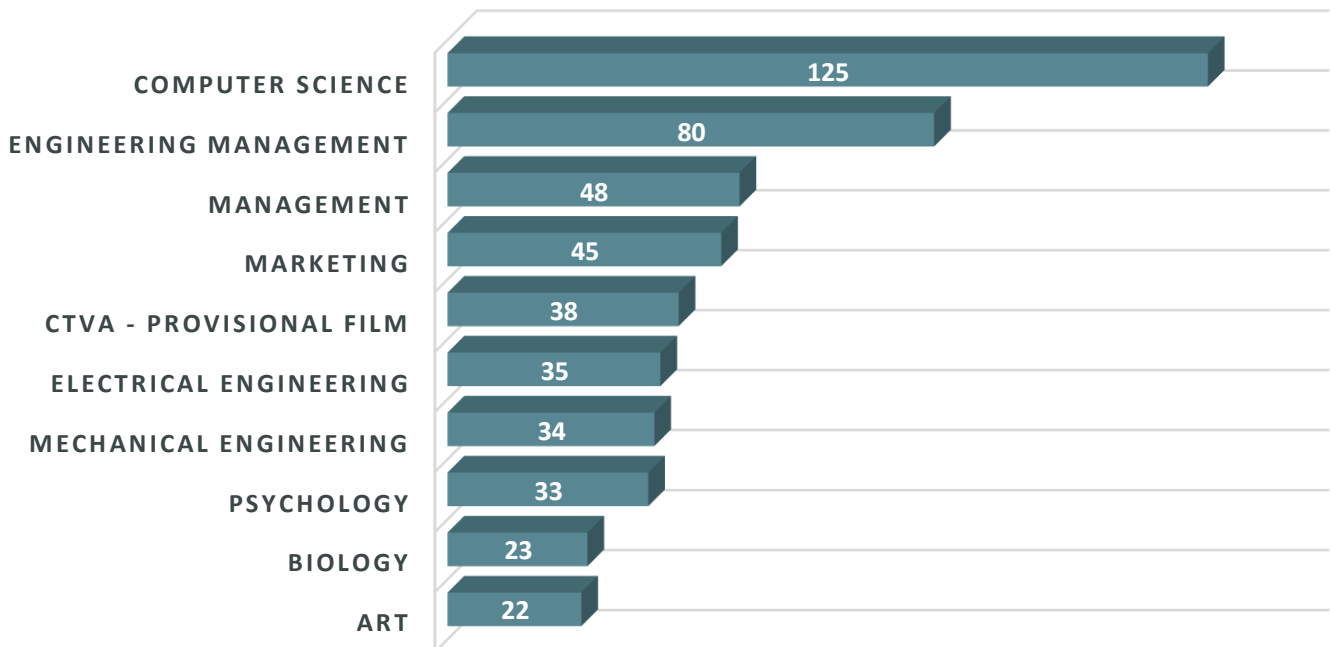
TOP 10 COUNTRIES - FALL 2021
