Non-EOP First-Time-Freshmen (FTF)	<i>Non EOP Fall 2021</i> students are advised by the HUB – refer students to access the following link for an advisement appointment: https://www.csun.edu/thehub .				
EOP First-Time-Freshmen (FTF)	<i>Fall 2021 FTF EOP</i> students can start calling the Center for an advisement appointment <u>starting May 28, 2021</u> . Appointments are made with Karim or Maria.				
2nd Semester Freshmen with 30+ units <i>Referred by the HUB</i>	<i>Fall 2020 FTF</i> students with 30+ units in <i>GOOD STANDING</i> will be receiving an email and or/appointment campaign instructing them to call our Center for an advisement appointment now.				
Continuing Students with 59 units or less <i>(not on probation or APA or EOP)</i>	These students will be receiving an email and/or appointment campaign instructing them that they can schedule a one-on-one advisement session from now through May 1, 2021. <i>After May 1, 2021</i> , students will need to attend an advisement session <u>via a workshop format</u> . The sessions will be coordinated between the Center and the Department Chairs, especially for the majors with large student #'s (Computer Science and Mechanical Engineering).				
Continuing Students with 60+ <i>(not on probation or APA or EOP)</i>	These students will be referred to their major department for Fall 2021 advisement starting the week of March 15, 2020.				
First Time Transfers (FTT - refer to New Student Welcome Letter link - page 8) NOTE – web info will be uploaded soon.	These students will receive a welcome letter from the Center and Associate Dean inviting them to contact us in <u>Mid-May</u> to attend a General Session in coordination with Major Department on Advisement. The Sessions will be held in June, July and August 2021. Attending the session is on a voluntary basis.				
EOP Continuing Students <i>(regardless of units)</i>	Students will be receiving an email and or/appointment campaign instructing them to call our Center for an advisement appointment now.				
Probation Students or Academic Performance Agreement (APA) – regardless of units	<i>Non-Fall 2020 FTF or EOP students</i> : Students will receive an email and or/appointment campaign instructing them to call our Center for an advisement appointment now. <u>Note: Fall 2020 FTF (Non-EOP) will need to wait until the HUB refers them for additional assistance (after May 28, 2021)</u> . At this time, they should be referred to the HUB for fall 2021 advisement: https://www.csun.edu/thehub .				
Disqualified Undergraduate Students <i>(non- matriculating regardless of units)</i>	It is <u>highly</u> recommended that students attend a general workshop on <i>Readmission Guidelines</i> BEFORE meeting with their major department to complete the <u>Conditions for Readmission</u> . <i>Readmission Workshops</i> will be conducted by the CECS SSC/EOP Center staff in Late January/February and in Mid-June/July of each year.
