

## **First Day of School:**

On the first day of school only, we strongly suggest that parents walk their child(ren) on to campus. Please plan to be early. All students should arrive by 7:45 A.M.

**Parking:** Lot B-6.

You **must** clearly display a CSUN parking permit at all times; you may/will receive a parking ticket if you do not. The Parking and Transportation office will be selling permits online. When the site is ready, we will have a link on our site that redirects you to their site. You will be able to buy your parking pass through this site and then print the permit out at home.

The SAEP parking permit allows for 90-minute parking for drop off and pick up only—not for a full day of parking. If you do not wish to have one of our permitDaily parking permits cost \$6.00, and may be purchased at the Information Booth #1 (Lindley Ave.) or Information Booth #2 (Prairie St.) or at one of the parking kiosks located in each parking area.

**Teachers - Students:** Each teacher will be standing by a class sign arranged by subject in alphabetical order on the Jacaranda Walk. Please have your student find his/her first period or Academic teacher.

The teacher will walk the students to the classroom promptly at 8:00 A.M. The Elective and Enrichment students will be returned to the Jacaranda Walk at the end of Period 1. There will be a break. Then students will be met by their Period 2 teacher who will walk them to class and return them to the Jacaranda Walk at the end of the first day.

**For the first day only,** please plan to pick up your student either on the Jacaranda Walk or in Lot B-6. After the first day, you can choose an alternative meeting place to pick up your child at the end of the day. (See the [Drop Off/ Pick Up](#) document for suggestions.)

We will have an information table set up in front of the Education Building with a knowledgeable staff person attending it for the entire school day during the first week of the program. The teachers will point out the table, as well as the SAEP office (Education 1119), on their way to the classrooms. This will help orient the students to campus, as well as give them a place to go if they have questions.

Although our teachers will only escort students on the first day, every building has TAs assigned to it. The TAs can assist students in locating classrooms, restrooms and places to buy food.
