## Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicants must be majoring or minoring in Spanish, or completing their M.A. Program in Spanish at the MCLL Dept.
- Graduate students must enroll in at least 4 units during the 2023-2024 academic year.
- Graduate students must have a minimum 3.20 cumulative GPA.
- Undergraduate students must enroll in at least 6 units during the 2023-2024 academic year.
- Undergraduate students must have a minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA.
- Undergraduate students must have completed at least 12 units.
- All applicants must have a FAFSA or CA Dream Act application on line.

## Application Documents:

- Degree Progress Report or copy of the transcripts.
- Personal essay describing your academic and career goals, as well as why Spanish language is important to achieving your goals
- Two recommendation letters or the contact information of two CSUN faculty members who know the student from an academic standpoint (Transfer students may provide the contact information of two faculty members of their previous institution).
