



KEITH GOLDSTEIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP 2022 APPLICATION

This scholarship honors Keith Goldstein, the longtime KCSN News director who passed away in May 2016. Keith often referred to himself as an "old-school journalist." He devoted his life to teaching our students the all-important foundation skills needed in the workplace. Many of his former students can be heard on many local/regional broadcast outlets, ranging from KFI-FM and NBC4 to KPCC and beyond.

Qualifications

A qualified recipient must be a full-time undergraduate student enrolled as a major in the Journalism Department. Submission is allowed on any platform or format. Application must include a cover letter, explaining the portfolio's focus and content.

Selection

The recipient will be selected through competitive review of applicants' portfolios, which should represent a cross-section of their media work. The scholarship will be awarded, based on these criteria:

Criteria

The work presented must have been distributed, implemented or tested by student, university, citizen or professional media or public relations outlets.

Portfolios must:

- include journalistic, public relations and/or scholarly work completed as a CSUN student.
- show creative, independent and critical-thinking ability;
- represent high ethical and research standards;
- demonstrate diversity of subjects and people portrayed; and/or diversity of publics and communities engaged.
