

Graduate Students - Tuition and Fees Fall 2023 & Spring 2024

Full-time enrollment = 3 classes (9 units) per semester

Part-time enrollment = 1-2 classes (3-6 units) per semester

*To be eligible for financial aid, graduate students must be enrolled in 4 or more units/semester.

Non-Resident and International Students are required to pay the tuition and fees noted above plus \$396 for each unit they are enrolled in.

Applying for Financial Aid

We recommend that applicants submit a [FAFSA \(Free Application for Federal Student Aid\)](#) as early as possible. You can submit your FAFSA prior to submitting your application for the M.A. program.

- Indicate on your FAFSA that California State University Northridge is one of the schools you want your information to be sent.
- The FAFSA priority filing deadline for Fall applicants is March 1st. To be eligible for SUG (State University Grants) applicants must submit their FAFSA by the priority filing deadline.
- There is no specific FAFSA priority date for Spring applicants, however we suggest submitting your FAFSA as soon as you know you will be applying for graduate school.
