# **Applying for Financial Aid**

We recommend that applicants submit a <u>FAFSA</u> (<u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid</u>) as early as possible. You can submit your FAFSA prior to submitting your application for the M.A. program.

- Indicate on your FAFSA that California State University Northridge is one of the schools you want your information to be sent.
- The FAFSA priority filing deadline for Fall applicants is March 1<sup>st</sup>. To be eligible for SUG (State University Grants) applicants must submit their FAFSA by the priority filing deadline.
- There is no specific FAFSA priority date for Spring applicants, however we suggest submitting your FAFSA as soon as you know you will be applying for graduate school.
