

SPRING 2024 REGISTRATION CHECKLIST

Around mid-late September you will be receiving an email through your CSUN email account that for you may schedule your advisement appointment. This appointment will go over how you are doing in your current classes and we will recommend you your Spring 2024 semester courses. We will NOT be helping you enroll into courses but will provide you the resources to do so.

Once your advisement appointment is completed, then you will be able to self-enroll into courses on the date and time assigned to you on your portal.
