Keep Teaching- Emergency Toolkit Checklist

In order to be prepared for an emergency, this emergency "toolkit" should be considered and put in place ahead of an actual emergency. This is a list of suggested items to consider when building your toolkit:

- □ Emergency plan for digital delivery of course
- □ Computer with Internet access (off-campus)
- □ Webcam and microphone
- □ Up-to-date computer, operating system and software
- □ <u>Zoom</u>¹ installed on your computer (do a test session so you are familiar). Review <u>Zoom</u> <u>tutorials</u>² for functions like recording, exporting a recording, and screen sharing.
- CSUN Credentials (make sure you can access all systems necessary from home with your CSUN user ID and password)
- □ Access to campus systems using <u>VPN</u>³ (ex. Library resources, college storage)*
- □ Ensure that all necessary files are stored in <u>myCSUNBox</u>⁴ or <u>Canvas</u>⁵
- □ A contact list for students and College Administration
- □ Access to essential software or a back-up plan
- Communication plan for students

*If you have access to <u>level one⁶</u> data you will need to activate <u>DUO</u>⁷ (multi-factor authentication) prior to accessing the system off-site.
