



LISA ENDIG JOURNALISM WRITING SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

This **\$1,000** scholarship honors the memory of Lisa Endig, a CSUN broadcast student, who went on to become an Emmy-winning documentary writer-producer before dying of cancer in 1989 at age 36. The scholarship, supported by contributions from her family, friends and colleagues, will be awarded to a journalism student, **undergraduate or graduate**, who shows outstanding ability in writing for broadcast or print. The applicants' academic records will be a consideration, with a preference toward students with a GPA of 2.5 or better. The scholarship committee will also give consideration to students who are overcoming difficulties while continuing their education. All recipients must be enrolled in the Spring semester and with a minimum of 6 units remaining in the Fall semester. Applicants are required to submit examples of their journalistic work. This includes writing that was broadcast on KCSN, Valley View, Matador News and On Point or published in *The Sundial*, *Scene* or *El Nuevo Sol*.
