Dear Dianne:

This is to confirm that California State University, Northridge (CSUN) has been granted an extension on select elements on Executive Order (EO) 1100- Revised General Education Breadth Requirements. Specifically, CSUN is granted an extension until fall 2019 to bring CSUN into alignment with EO-1100-Revised with the previously approved exception for the maintenance of the six-unit CSUN requirement in Area F. In formally granting an implementation extension, we wish to confirm the following expectations:

CSUN will maintain the six units of Area F (Comparative Cross-Cultural Studies) within the 48-unit GE limit. Thus Area F remains a distinct section within CSUN's GE program alongside Area A, B, C, D and E.

- a. Catalogs, websites and other materials may continue identifying courses as Area F, Comparative Cross-Cultural Studies.
- b. Transfer students will not be required to take additional lower-division Area F courses if the students have satisfied lower-division Areas C and D requirements at another institution (including another CSU campus).
- c. ADT transfer students may be required to complete upper-division Area F courses only if those courses are already specified in the 60 units of baccalaureate-completion requirements for the ADT-to-bachelor's degree.

All of the other elements of EO-1100-Revised will be implemented by CSUN in time for inclusion in the fall 2019 campus catalog. No further extensions beyond fall 2019 will be granted for full implementation of EO-1100-Revised.
