

BETTER SERVED STUDENTS


Northridge has made limited progress toward its 2025 goal that there will be 0% difference in the 6-year graduation rates of traditionally underserved and better served students.

Northridge has made limited progress toward its 2025 goal that there will be 0% difference in the 6-year graduation rates of Pell and Non-Pell students.


