



### From the 405 FWY:

Exit Nordhoff St. in the San Fernando Valley. Turn west onto Nordhoff and go about 3 miles until you reach Zelzah Ave. Immediately after passing Zelzah Ave., you will make your first right on Matador Rd. Turn right at the first stop sign to enter parking lot G1. Monterey Hall is directly in front of parking lot G1. The Language, Speech and Hearing Center will be on the first floor of Monterey Hall, Room 100A.

#### From the 118 FWY:

Exit the 118 FWY at Reseda Blvd. Follow signs to Reseda Blvd and/or turn south on Reseda Blvd. depending on exit. Go about 3 miles and turn left on Nordhoff St. Next, turn left on Zelzah Ave. Make the first possible left on Prairie St. Turn left at the first stop sign. You will pass parking lot G3 and continue straight past the next stop sign. Turn left into parking lot G1.
