These affordable lessons are offered for young swimmers of all skill levels utilizing the American Red Cross guidelines and teaching techniques.

- WHY:** Provide all SRC members with affordable and convenient swimming lessons for their kids and grandkids that will provide an excellent learning experience.
- BACKGROUND:** SRC members can enroll their children to take these extremely beneficial classes for only \$23 per child. All participants **MUST** be SRC members in order to sign up their children or grandchildren for swim lessons. A swim diaper must be worn by participants in the levels Parent and Me, Tiny Tots, and for Level 1 of Levels 1-5 (optionally for Level 2). Parents or guardians must present a birth certificate for enrolled child upon arrival on the first day of their lessons. Free swim diapers will be provided to any little swimmer in need.
