MANUAL CREDENTIAL APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The following situations require a Manual Credential Application process:

- ❖ All candidates applying under the Prelingually Deaf Option
- ❖ Education specialist candidates adding a new specialty area of authorization (Example; MM adding MS)
- ❖ Intern candidates requesting an appeal or change of employer or authorization
- Educators who already hold a clear teaching credential in one area, either general education or special education, who have completed a preliminary credential program in a different teaching area. These educators are entitled to be granted a clear teaching credential in the new credential type.

Please submit the following items to the Credential Office

- Application Form 41-4
- This form can be located on the Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) website at http://www.ctc.ca.gov/credentials/leaflets/414.pdf. Complete sections 1, 2, 3, 6, 7 & 9. Print and sign the form. Do not complete sections 4, 5 or 8; these are for office use only.
- \$100 Money Order or Cashier's Check made payable to CTC Cash, personal checks and credit cards are NOT accepted.
- Credential Request Form
 Follow the instructions on the Credential Request form and include all necessary documentation.

Additional required items for Preliminary Prelingually Deaf Candidates:

- Letter from a physician or licensed audiologist clearly stating that you are prelingually deaf.
- Audiologist Report
