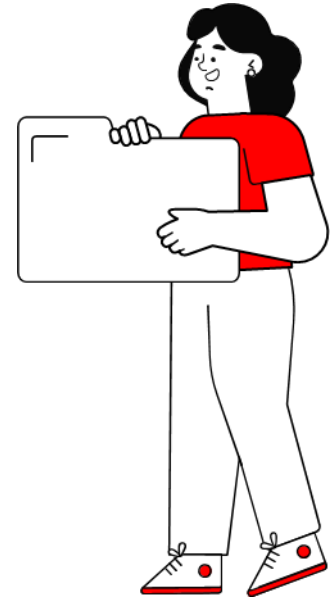

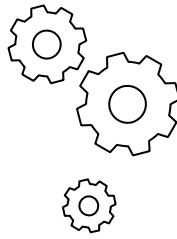
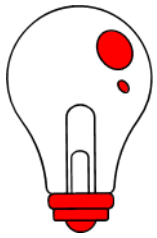


DEGREE PROGRESS REPORT (DPR)



- **An individualized audit that outlines the requirements you must complete to earn your degree**
 - What you will find on the DPR:
 - Classes taken
 - How many units needed in each section
 - Class options/ required classes
 - Calculation of units earned (minimum 120 units required)
 - **Disclaimer:** You may graduate with more than 120 units





IMPORTANT SYMBOLS ON THE DPR

- **NO** = means something is still needed in that section & lists specifically what you need.

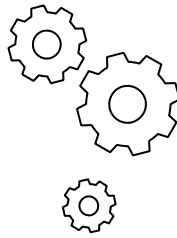
I. LOWER DIVISION GENERAL EDUCATION

Community College Transfer Students will usually have completed all or most of the lower division general education courses upon transfer.



- ***If any lower division general education requirements have not been completed, those requirements must be completed prior to graduation***
 - Needed courses can be good options for your first semester and may be able to double count with needed Upper Division Gen Ed classes

2. UPPER DIVISION GENERAL EDUCATION



9 units of Junior level General Education will be taken at CSUN

3 units will be covered by an Upper Division Business Core or major requirement:

- *FIN 303*
- *ECON 309* for Economics majors

6 units will be selected from either:

- **Section C:** Arts & Humanities
- **Section D:** Social Sciences
- **Section F:** Comparative Cultural Studies

Work with an advisor to identify the ideal sections to take to complete this area



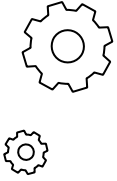
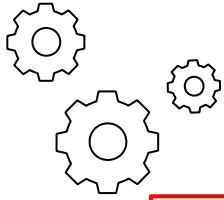
3. LOWER DIVISION BUSINESS CORE

LOWER DIVISION CORE REQUIREMENTS (27 UNITS)

ACCT 220	Intro to Financial Accounting (3) <i>Prerequisites: A grade of "C" or higher in MATH 103 or higher-level mathematics course and sophomore standing</i>
ACCT 230	Intro to Managerial Accounting (3) <i>Prerequisite: ACCT 220</i>
ECON 160	Principles of Microeconomics (3) <i>Prerequisites: Multiple Measures Placement in (1) GE-level Mathematics and (2) GE-level Written Communication or completion of 113A or 114A.</i>
ECON 161	Principles of Macroeconomics (3) <i>Prerequisites: ECON 160</i>
IS 212	Info Systems for Business Users (3)
SOM 120*	Basic Business Statistics (3) <i>Prerequisite: A grade of "C" or higher in MATH 103 or higher-level mathematics course</i> *The 4-unit MATH 140 course also satisfies this requirement
ENGL 205	Business Communication (3) <i>Prerequisite: Completion of Lower Division Writing Exam. Recommended Preparatory: AAS/AFRS/CAS/CHS/COMS 151 or equivalent; IS 212 or equivalent.</i>
BLAW 280	Business Law I (3) <i>Prerequisites: Completion of lower division writing requirement and sophomore standing</i>
MATH 103**	Mathematical Methods for Bus (3) <i>Prerequisites: Eligibility for GE level mathematics</i> **MATH 103 or higher-level mathematics course must be completed with a "C" or higher.

- All Lower Division Business Core classes taken at the community college **must be passed with a C or higher**
- Still missing some lower division business core? That's okay!
 - Can complete remaining lower division business core at CSUN ☺





4. UPPER DIVISION BUSINESS CORE

UPPER DIVISION CORE REQUIREMENTS (19 UNITS)

BUS 302 Gateway Experience (3)
Prerequisites: Junior Standing, Lower Division Business Core: ACCT 220, ACCT 230, ECON 160, ECON 161, IS 212, SOM 120 or MATH 140, ENGL 205, BLAW 280, and MATH 103. Corequisite: BUS 302L

BUS 302L Gateway Lab (1)
Prerequisites: Junior standing and completion of all Lower Division Business Core courses. Corequisite: BUS 302.

FIN 303 Financial Management (3)
Pre/Corequisite for Business Majors: BUS 302 +302L

MGT360 Management and Org. Behavior (3)
Pre/Corequisite for Business Majors: BUS 302 +302L

MKT 304 Marketing Management (3)
Pre/Corequisite for Business Majors: BUS 302 +302L

SOM 306 Operations Management (3)
Pre/Corequisite for Business Majors: BUS 302+302L

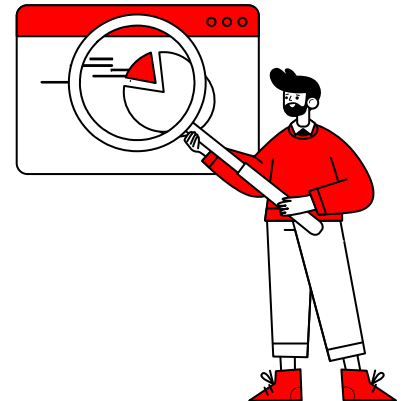
BUS 497 Capstone: Strategic Management (3)
Prerequisites: Senior standing; BUS 302+302L, FIN 303, MGT 360, MKT 304; Graduating senior standing

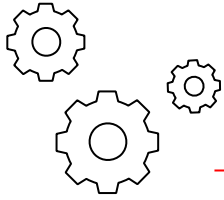
- All Lower Division Business Core classes **must be completed** before you can enroll in any Upper Division Business Core Classes such as:

- BUS 302 (3 units)
- BUS 302 L (1 unit)

- **Must be enrolled in BUS 302 & BUS 302L** to enroll in other upper division Business Core such as:

- FIN 303
- MGT 360
- MKT 304
- SOM 306

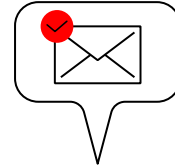
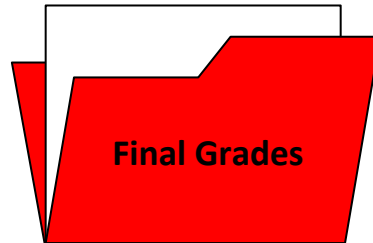
Are you currently enrolled in or planning to take your last Lower Division Business Core over the summer?

- **Submit proof of a C (or higher grade)** prior to the beginning of the semester

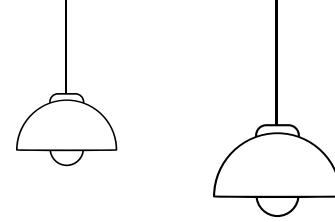

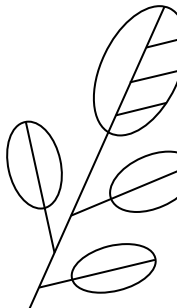
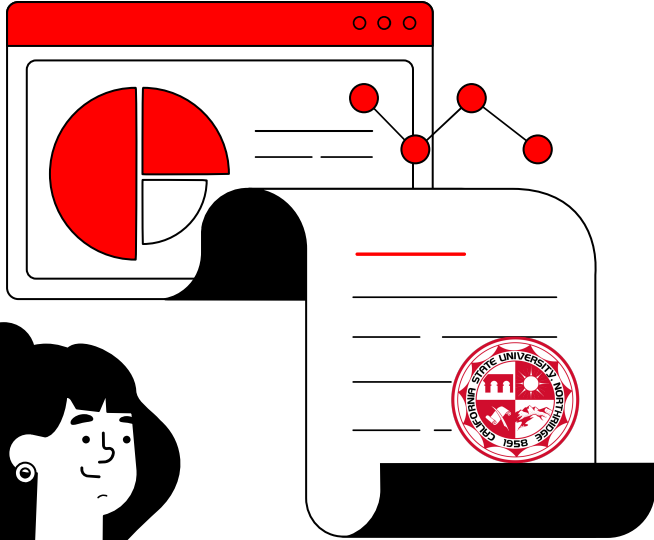

5. OTHER DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

- **GPA Requirements**
 - Overall GPA = 2.0+
 - CSUN GPA = 2.0+
 - Upper Division Major GPA = 2.0+
- **Various Residency Unit Requirements**
- **Minimum 120 units to graduate**

- Taking **15 units per semester** (or using the summer session to earn 30 units per year) will help you graduate in a timely manner

 - Other activities

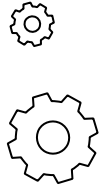

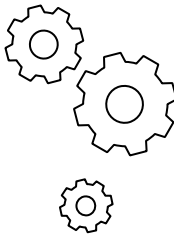

DATES & REMINDERS

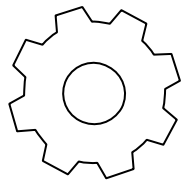
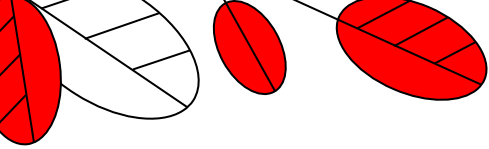


- Students may add up to **17 units** per semester
- After the first week of school, students must obtain a permission number to **ADD** classes.
- Students can **DROP** courses during the first four weeks of the semester (**Deadline Sept 24, 2023**)

- **Registration-by-Appointment:** Check portal now to find your date!



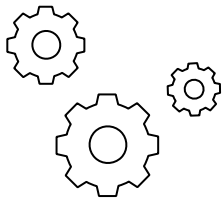
