B. Section 600/700 Policy Changes

- a. Approved by PP&R and Faculty Senate
 - a) 706.1 Establishment and Approval of Departmental Criteria and Evaluation Procedures This policy was updated to include consultation with lecturer faculty.
 - b) **622.5.2 Evaluation of Associate Deans**—This policy was updated to mirror other reviews of administrators.
 - c) **645.4 Periodic Review of Tenured Faculty** For departments following Section 600 for post-tenure review, requires candidates to submit a summary of activities with an updated CV.
 - d) **604.12 Professional Responsibility** This will require tenure-track faculty to submit required course materials in advance of the next semester to allow for student accommodation.
 - e) **612.2.3 Dual Service** This policy clarifies when a faculty member may serve on more than one personnel committee and the importance of not casting two votes on any one RTP case.
- b. Approved by PP&R and Senate Exec (to be reviewed by Faculty Senate in Fall 2023)
 - a) **Equity Language in Section 621-622** this policy would update passive references to equity and diversity in favor of a stronger commitment to justice, equity, diversity, inclusion, and accessibility.
 - b) **Preamble to Sections 600 and 700** this new preamble would emphasize the importance of the university's values (justice, equity, diversity, inclusion, and accessibility) when interpreting policy.
