"Our HEAL Project MSW Intern, the student and myself will work together to ensure the student has the necessary tools to thrive here at CSUN."

Interested students will meet with Jessica Aceves and HEAL Project Master in Social Work (MSW) Intern, who both advocate for student success and work to discover opportunities for students to thrive in college. The collaborative process between the student, HEAL Project Coordinator and support from the MSW intern, will address the barriers and stressors that can impact a student's mental health and academic success. The student will be connected to resources and services that will further support their academic journey.



The HEAL Project does not provide therapy, instead, it creates a relationship that provides welcoming support to students relevant to their academic life. The program is based on a healing-centered engagement (HCE) and a holistic educational approach to working with communities who have faced impacts from systemic inequities.
