

Reading Assignment #2: Read about important ways to present

Here are the things you will need to know about this reading assignment. You will need to submit documents in Moodle. Please read carefully:

I. Read pages 108 – 111 of the book, “Graphic Design Thinking: Beyond Brainstorming.”

A. While you are reading reiterate the content through one or both of the following formats. You need to show the professor that you read the pages and you are learning the concepts.

- **Digital photo of your sketchbook:**

This format needs to be .jpg(s) of your handwritten diagrams, sketches, notes, and ideas. All the ideas, comments and reflection are based on the reading but can include other related thoughts and notes from other projects you have done. These are reflections and ways to relate the readings to your experiences.

Or

- **Digital typed Document:**

This format needs to be .doc / .docx / .rtf / .pdf of notes written about the reading or your own concepts or outline about your presentation.

II. Part 3: Read two (2) of the articles listed in Moodle on Monday 9/15

A. After Reading at least 2 of articles, do the following.

- **About the articles:**

- List key things the readings provide about creating a digital presentation.

- **Your presentation:**

- Create an outline of what you will be talking about in your presentation.
- Include a script (what you think you will talk about.)
- No images
- Provide a structure: This must be done in an outline form. Use bullets, lists, numbers, indent, etc to make the outline about what you will be talking about in your presentation.

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III. Important:

- Make sure your handwriting is clear and the digital photos are clear as well. Sometimes the best solution is to take the photos outside in a shaded area. But if you use a pencil, the information can be hard to read; so make sure it is clear and has a strong contrast.
- There is a limit to the number of photos you may submit (**no more than 20 photos**). Therefore, close up photos of the notes sometime help see details.
- Whatever format you choose you should consider the fact that you are highlighting and reflecting on what you have read and learned. So any comments show reflection.
