

## Survey Interviewer Position (UCLA RISE UP-T2A Study)

The UCLA RISE UP-T2A (Transition to Adult) Study is a follow up to the RISE UP-High School study that was done as a collaborative project between UCLA researchers at the School of Medicine and charter schools across Los Angeles County. The study is designed to determine the long-term impact of high-performing schools on educational achievement, health, and health-related behaviors among students. We plan to follow the same participants as they transition to young adults. The results will provide extraordinary and compelling evidence for participating schools that education reform can be achieved, and that such reform has a wide range of benefits to society including better health.

**POSITION SUMMARY:** We are hiring a **part-time bilingual (Spanish and English) survey interviewer** to work an average of 10-24 hours per week from November 2019 through March 2020 (depending on data collection progress), with the potential to be hired long term for follow-up data collection over the remainder of the study. Interviewers will be responsible for administering a survey with participants via phone, in person, or online. Interviewer must be comfortable traveling to participants' homes or designated survey interview locations (i.e. schools, parks or community centers). Other duties will include data entry, faxing, emailing, and making phone calls. Training will be provided.

**DESIRED SKILLS:** Competitive candidates will be available and willing to work evenings and weekends and are comfortable with adapting to participant availability and study needs. Must have effective communication skills through speech, listening, and fluency in English and Spanish. We are looking for a candidate who will be dedicated to performing duties according to study protocol and who is prompt and reliable. The candidate must also be incredibly diligent, organized, flexible, responsive, and able to work well in a team setting.

Pay rate: \$17.10 per hour

Hours: Will begin with a schedule of Mondays-Thursdays from 11am-8pm – exact hours will be determined by participant availability. With advance notification, may be asked to work 2 weekend days a month (Saturday between 10am-4pm and/or Sunday 1-7pm) to complete data collection.
