\$35,000 stipend to pursue a Multiple Subject Teaching Credential



Are You Eligible?

- ACT Program candidates focusing on Transitional K/K (Kindergarten) with an undergraduate Child and Adolescent (CADV) emphasis in early childhood development or a Bilingual Added Authorization
- Candidates completing the final year of the post-baccalaureate traditional (TRAD) program focusing on Transitional Kindergarten or Kindergarten (TK/K). Eligibility requires an undergraduate Child and Adolescent (CADV) emphasis in early childhood development.
- Candidates completing the final year of the post-baccalaureate traditional (TRAD) program or the undergraduate integrated program (ITEP) with a **Bilingual Added Authorization**.

Students must commit to teach in LAUSD for 4 years after obtaining their credential.
