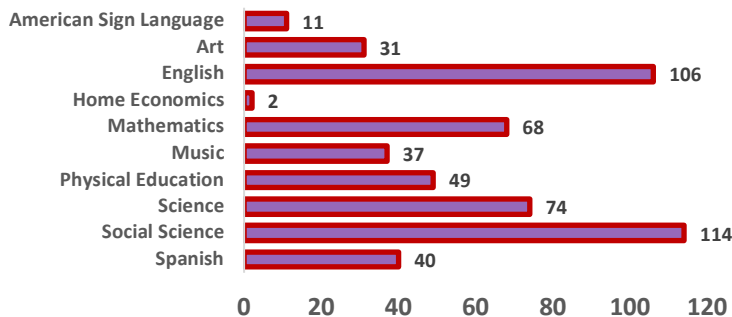


Featuring the Secondary Education Credential Program

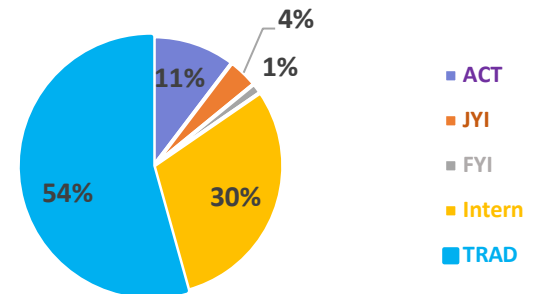
Did You Know That...

The Department of Secondary Education made 532 field assignment placements during the 2021-2022 academic year (274 in Fall 2021 and 258 in Spring 2022). These candidates, interested in teaching in a variety of subject areas, participated in five credential pathways: part- or full-time Traditional (TRAD) program, 1-year full-time cohort-based Accelerated Collaborative Teacher (ACT) Program, 2-year Intern Program for on-the-job teachers, and the Undergraduate 4-year (FYI) or 2-year (JYI) Integrated Programs.

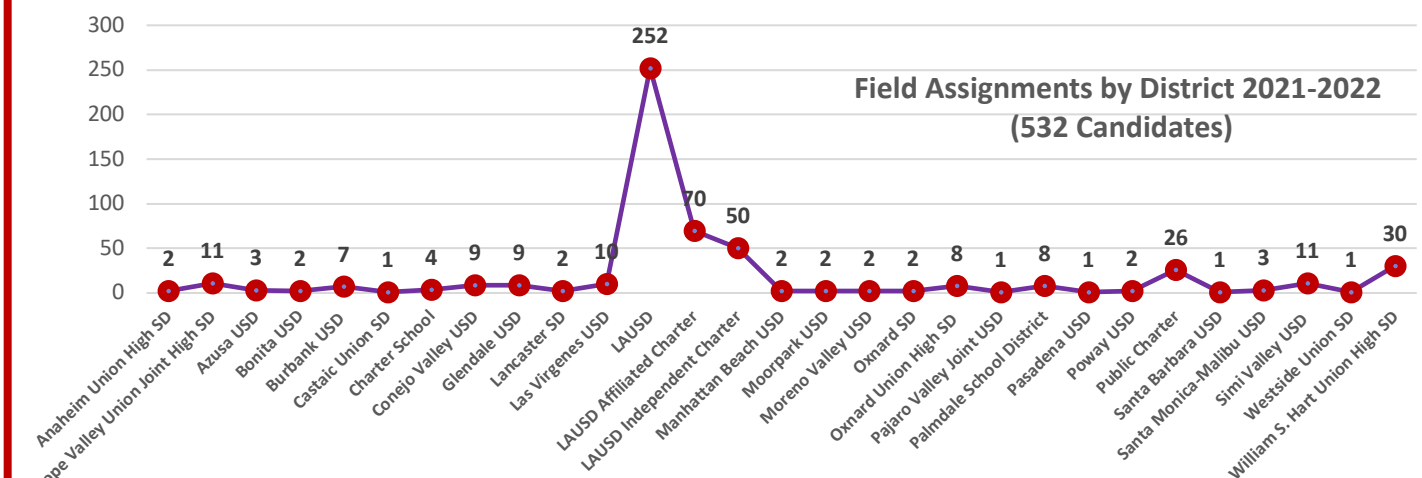
**Number of Candidates in Each Subject Area
