

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES Chain Hoist

DO NOT use this machine unless you have received authorization from the Shop Coordinator



Hard hat must be worn at all times.



Gloves must be worn. Beware of pinch points.



Sturdy, closed-toe work boots must be worn at all times.

Potential Hazards and Injuries

- ⚠ Foot Injury
- Mead Injury
- ⚠ Hand Injury
- ▲ Struck by falling objects

Pre-Operational Safety Checks

- ✓ Make sure safety latch is in good condition and is engaged.
- ✓ Make sure the tie-off point is stable and adequate for the load.
- ✓ Be careful of the load swinging. All hoists must be inspected and certified annually.
- ✓ Safety training is required before operation, including rigging techniques.
- ✓ Only authorized users can operate equipment.
- ✓ Report any observed defect or safety hazard to your supervisor immediately.
- ✓ Inspect the hoist and tie-off point before every use

Safe Practices During Operation

- ✓ Maintain situational awareness.
- ✓ Eye and hand protection along with electrical safety should be practiced during operation.
- ✓ Operate equipment in strict accordance with Manufacturer's instructions.

DON'T

- 8 Never exceed the maximum load capacity.
- On not stand under an elevated load.
