Pre-Operational Safety Checks

- ✓ Demarcate the work area.
- ✓ Inspect for damaged or loose components.
- ✓ Ensure the blade is securely attached to the pole.
- ✓ Visually inspect the blade to ensure it appears sharp.
- Pole pruner ensure the spring is functioning properly.
- If the blade does not return to the open position, a dab of oil, cleaning or deburring may be required.

Safe Practices During Operation

- Maintain safe distance between employees while using the tree pruner.
- If blade is loose, tighten the wing nut to ensure the blade is secured in the open position.
- Maintain a stable, balanced position while operating the saw.
- ✓ Plan for and maintain an exit route to avoid impacts from falling limbs.

DON'T

- Do not have tree workers carry hand tools and equipment in their hands unless they are tools used to assist them in their climbing.
- Never throw the saw into a tree, out of a tree or between workers aloft.
- Never stand under the branch being cut.
