

Student Success Information Sheet

ACADEMIC PROBATION

Students are placed on Academic Probation if either their CSUN grade point average (GPA) or Cumulative Total GPA falls below 2.00 at the end of any term.

DISQUALIFICATION

Students who are on academic probation are at risk of being disqualified. Probationary students will be disqualified if their CSUN or Cumulative Total GPAs do not reach the minimum GPA as determined by their class level (below). A disqualified student will no longer be eligible to enroll at CSUN as a matriculated student and might not be eligible to continue in the Nazarian College of Business and Economics.

Class Level	Minimum CSUN and Cumulative GPA Requirement
Freshman (1-29 units earned)	----- ➤ 1.50
Sophomore (30-59 units earned)	----- ➤ 1.70
Junior (60-89 units earned)	----- ➤ 1.85
Senior (90 + units earned)	----- ➤ 1.95

Note: Units earned includes CSUN developmental units passed. Meeting the minimum GPA levels may not be sufficient to meet the minimum 2.00 GPA levels for graduation. CSUN, Cumulative Total, and upper division major GPAs must all be minimum 2.00 or higher for graduation.

REPEAT POLICY/GRADE FORGIVENESS

You may be eligible for grade forgiveness. A maximum of 16 semester units of CSUN coursework may be repeated for the purpose of excluding grades (or grade forgiveness) from a student's CSUN and overall GPA. This policy only applies to courses taken **and** repeated at CSUN. Only courses with a "C-" or lower may be repeated for grade forgiveness. Note: You must pass all required courses in the major with specified grades within two enrollment attempts. Students with two unsuccessful attempts are no longer eligible to continue in their program and should select another major outside of Nazarian College of Business and Economics.
