

TOM REILLY STUDENT JOURNALISM ENTERPRISE FUND 2022 APPLICATION

Tom Reilly, a faculty member in CSUN's Department of Journalism for 32 years, established the Tom Reilly Student Journalism Enterprise Fund. Dr. Reilly earned his degree from this Department in 1965, and also chaired the Department for 12 years. He retired in 2001. This fund awards one or more students up to \$2,000 each for a student project or enterprise that is part of the student's curriculum. Friends and faculty members also contributed to honor Dr. Reilly after his death in May 2002.

The award supports instructionally related project expenses, which may include travel funding, conference or event fees, technology, materials or other opportunity related costs.

The scholarship is open to all Journalism majors, who are at least juniors, and Mass Communication graduate students, who are attending CSUN on a full-time basis (at least 12 units for undergraduate students and six units for graduate students or enrolled in Thesis). Preference will be given to student projects and enterprises that engage news reporting and presentation and that are disseminated as part of any of the Department's student media. Disbursement of funds is subject to submission of a detailed budget.
