# Examples in Los Angeles

**The Youth Policy Institute (YPI)** is seeking a part-time Afterschool Youth Leader for its Expanded Learning department. This position will provide homework assistance and a variety of academic, enrichment and recreational activities for students. The Afterschool Youth Leader works under the supervision of the Site Coordinator.

**Salvadoran American Leadership and Educational Fund:** Full-time position available immediately to coordinate and conduct the community outreach and organizing strategies of SALEF, including, education forums around immigration issues such as TPS, DACA, citizenship services as well as other SALEF's community projects, such as school improvement projects, community development projects, etc. Implement SALEF's community organizing strategy through the implementation of SALEF's Comites Civicos network and the LIDER leadership development project with youth and adults; and develop SALEF's organizing and mobilizing base.

**CHIRLA:** The Campaign Coordinator is responsible for coordinating the work of the Los Angeles Raids Rapid Response Network (LA-RRRN), planning, implementing, and evaluating activities associated with the coalition to include providing: general oversight for coalition activities and associated projects; grant development, submission, and management; and technical assistance to local/regional coalitions and partnerships that focus on immigration related issues. The Campaign Coordinator will work to develop and implement strategies that will lead to long-term involvement of community institutions, organizations and individuals in the promotion, assessment, and evaluation of coalition activities.

**SVDP:** Case Manager--Ability to outreach to, and engage homeless individuals, conduct thorough assessments, case planning, and case management services, including assisting clients in accessing behavioral and physical healthcare, educational, vocational, job search and placement needs, legal issues, benefits, and assist with determining eligibility, and providing assistance to apply for subsidized, and other permanent housing opportunities.
