Definition of a Youth Program: A Youth Program includes all events, operations, or activities designed for participation by minors, organized by The University Corporation (TUC), in which Youth Program Personnel are responsible for the care, custody, or control of minors. Typical youth programs include, but are not limited to, instructional programs, day camps, overnight camps, and sports camps.

Definition of a Minor: A Minor is any person under the age of 18.
