## Timely Warning Crime Bulletin Attempted Sexual Assault

This Timely Warning Bulletin is being issued in compliance with the Jeanne Clery Act and the purpose is to provide preventative information to the Campus community to aid members from becoming the victim of a similar crime.

**DATE/TIME:** April 22, 2024 at 10:14 A.M.

**LOCATIONS:** USU Men’s Bathroom, near computer lab

**REPORTED OFFENSE:** Attempted Sexual Assault—CSUN DPS was notified of an attempted sexual assault that occurred in the men’s restroom near the computer lab at the USU. DPS officers tracked the suspect via CCTV to the area of the CSUN Botanical Gardens but were unable to locate the suspect.

**Suspect:** The victim described the suspect as, a Male White or Hispanic in his 20’s, black hair, stubbly beard, 250lbs, last seen wearing a white t-shirt, blue jeans, and blue shoes.
