The California State University, Northridge Department of Police Services is providing this notice of a criminal activity that occurred in our community in order to provide information that may help in avoiding similar crimes or provide information that may lead to an arrest.

ATTEMPT ROBBERY

DATE/TIME: Tuesday February 23, 2016 at 6:18 PM

LOCATION: University Student Union

REPORTED OFFENSE: A male suspect riding a bicycle approached a female student walking on Matador Walk toward the Student Rec Center within the University Student Union. The suspect pointed what appeared to be a black semi-auto handgun toward the ground and demanded the victim give him all her money. Upon telling the suspect she had no money to give, the suspect told her not to yell and then rode north through the University Student Union and out of sight. No property was taken.
