Bicycle Registration

It's FREE! Registration helps improve the chances of return because we can identify the bike as yours! Call or visit the Department of Police Services (Darby & Prairie) or (818) 677-2111.

Make your bicycle a hard target

No lock is 100% theft-proof but hardened steel U-locks have proven to be much tougher when compared to cable locks. If possible, secure the **front tire & frame** to the bicycle rack. Never lock JUST the front tire.
