As a **CSUN student** with a CSUN student ID number, you have access to online resources such as **myNorthridge Portal**, your [CSUN Gmail](#) account, and the free [CSUN Mobile App](#).

- Go to www.csun.edu and select the myNorthridge Portal link to reveal the login panel.
- Select the portal, Gmail, Canvas learning platform, or Zoom, etc., to log in with the same CSUN user ID and password. Be sure to check your CSUN Gmail for important messages!

1. Many CSUN professors use the platform **Canvas**.
 - Check your CSUN email for your professor's invitation to join the Canvas class.
 - Log into Canvas through [myNorthridge Portal](#) on the "Home" tab (login required).
 - You can download the **Canvas App for Students** through the CSUN Mobile App, the App Store or Google Play. Select CSUN and log in with your CSUN user ID and password.
